Ford has a "Police Special" package designed to meet virtually all law enforcement requirements. Offered to police departments only, these extra-duty combinations of special components are available on Ford Custom and Custom 500 4-Door Sedans, Galaxie 500 2-Door Hardtops and 4-Door Sedans, and 6-Passenger Station Wagon models in the Custom and Custom 500 Ranch Wagon and the Country Sedan series. Detailed descriptions of the packages are included for your convenience in matching them to your individual service requirements.

DEPUTY


For general city and suburban patrol or utility duty, the Ford Police Deputy is an outstanding value. The special durability features, and economy and smoothness of its 7-bearing sixcylinder engine make it ideal for Police assignments. The 240-c.i.d. Police Special Six develops 150 hp at 4000 rpm and 234 lbs. ft. of torque at 2200 rpm with a 9.2 to 1 compression ratio. The Deputy Special engine features a precisioncast, seven bearing crankshaft, extra-duty bearings, chrometipped valve stems, rotators on the exhaust valves, hydraulic lifters with chrome plated plungers, gear driven cam shaft, single barrel carburetor with automatic choke, regular fuel, high-capacity long life fuel filter, disposable type (cartridge replacement) full flow oil filter, extra-duty cooling provided by an extra-fin density radiator and a shrouded fan, and single exhaust system with a stainless and aluminized steel muffler.

SENTINEL

The Ford Police Sentinel Package provides V-8 smoothness with brisk performance, thrifty operating economy and exceptional durability. The Sentinel is ideally suited to a multitude of duty assignments. The 351 c.i.d. Sentinel engine has 250 hp at 4600 rpm and develops 355 lbs. ft. of torque at 2600 rpm, and a 9.5 to 1 compression ratio allows the economy of regular fuel. This special purpose engine features



extra duty bearings, exhaust valve rotators, chromeplated valve stem tips on both intake and exhaust valves and hydraulic lifters. Extra-duty cooling is provided by an extra-fin density radiator and a shrouded fan. Other features of this package are identical to the Deputy.

GUARDIAN

The Guardian Package is built around the popular 390 c.i.d., 2-barrel carburetor V-8 engine. It fills the requirements for all-around patrol duty, with emphasis on city and suburban cruising. There is ample power available from its 265 hp at 4400 rpm and 390 lbs. ft. of torque at 2600 rpm. Free turn valves and ample bearings account for the long life expectancy of this popular powerplant. A 9.5 to 1 compression ratio allows the economy of regular gasoline. All other items are the same as those included on the Deputy except for an Interceptor Cooling Package with an Extra-Fin Density Radiator, and Shrouded Flex-Blade Fan.

CRUISER

This vehicle is second only to the Interceptor in total performance. It is especially suitable for use in the suburban areas where its exceptional low end torque gives it the acceleration capability to overtake quickly before high speeds have been reached. The 429 c.i.d. 2-barrel carburetor V-8 engine develops 320 hp at 4400 rpm and 460 lbs. ft. of torque at 2200 rpm with a 10.5 to 1 compression ratio. The single exhaust system features generous area headers with internal deflectors at the ports of the two middle cylinders to assure unrestricted flow. The muffler is aluminized and stainless steel for long life. Special Police features of the Cruiser Package are the same as the Deputy except for an 80-Ampere Heavy-Duty Battery and a Police Interceptor Extra-Cooling Package with an Extra-Fin Density Radiator and Shrouded Flex-Blade Fan. The Heavy-Duty SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic Transmission is mandatory at extra cost.

INTERCEPTOR

This is the maximum duty vehicle capable of sustained high speeds. The special 428 c.i.d. Police Interceptor engine develops 360 hp at 5400 rpm and 459 lbs. ft. of torque at 3200 rpm. It has 10.5 to 1 compression ratio and requires premium fuel. The Ford-designed 4-barrel carburetor offers smoother operation, steadier idle characteristics, and more reliable warm or cold starting. Chromed valve stems, a high lift cam, heavy-duty valve springs with one piece retainers and high rpm hydraulic valve lifters, plus a free flow dual exhaust system (single in wagons) with aluminized and stainless mufflers give this powerplant its exceptional durability for operation at high rpms.

The Interceptor Package also includes all the Special Police items included on the Deputy plus the following:


The long, 121-inch wheelbase and wide 64-inch track, smooth rough roads and provide better ride and handling characteristics, while maintaining a turning radius and maneuverability that is comparable to shorter wheelbase cars and is so essential to effective police work.

Ford's heavy-duty high-output MagicAire heater-defroster blends outside air with the heated air to achieve the temperature desired. The powerful three-speed blower is mounted outside the passenger compartment on the engine side of the heavily-insulated front bulkhead for quiet operation. A new "Flow-Thru," pressure relief ventilation system provides a flow of fresh air to all parts of the interior. With this new "windows-up" system, ventilating air, heated and unheated, enters at the front . . . circulates throughout the interior . . . and exits through openings under the rear seat into the trunk and out through the vents in the "B" pillar.

Back, under the rear deck, Ford gives you a big 18 cubicfeet of load space—room to carry radio receivers and ample first aid equipment. And, in station wagons, you get a huge 96 cubic-feet of load space plus a lockable storage compartment under the floor.

Up front, there's a power plant available to serve every department requirement, from the rugged Police Special Six to the high-performance Interceptor V-8.


The 1970 Ford INSTRUMENT PANEL is a unique concept in driver convenience. All instrumentation and controls are clustered directly before the driver for easy view and reach. The balance of the panel sweeps smoothly away providing exceptional leg room and freedom of movement for the front seat passenger plus ample space for emergency equipment and 2-way radios without limiting the usefulness of the front compartment. Underneath this "control center" is a printed electrical circuit to provide greater instrumentation reliability. Heavy-duty 100,000 mile front seat provides all-day comfort with thick 21/2" contour-molded foam-rubber-padded seat cushions. Firm support is added with special preformed main springs and coil springs while optional tough, beige-colored non-pleated vinyl provides a durable easyclean covering. Added convenience is found in Ford's new "uni-lock" three-point safety harness for the driver and outboard front seat passenger.


Ford's versatile SELECTSHIFT CRUISE-O-MATIC transmission provides the driver the option of completely automatic or manual shifting—to suit the terrain, road condition or traffic conditions. The transmission may be downshifted to second gear for surer starts on ice or for gentle engine braking when required. And, it may be up- or down-shifted for excellent driver control in adverse road or weather conditions. Cruise-O-Matic is standard with the Interceptor, required on the Cruiser, and optional on all other Packages.

Ford's new dual-diaphragm front disc and rear drum POWER BRAKES provide more positive stops. The cast iron discs are ventilated for better cooling and water dissipation. The braking system is dual hydraulic with dual master cylinders, each independent of the other with its own fluid reservoir and pumping section. Power brakes with front discs are standard on the Interceptor and optional on all other models.

Ford's latest addition to its "POLICE ENGINE" group is the rugged 351 c.i.d. 2v V-8 engine for the Sentinel package. Precision-cast for strength in the manner developed for lightweight racing engines, the 351 offers a distinct weight-to-displacement advantage over competitive engines for better economy and performance.

All of the 1970 Fords continue to use rugged engine chassis and power team components designed to keep your police cars on the road and maintenance-free. Features such as a tube-and-fin radiator (competition uses a "cellular" design); cast-and-coined rocker arms (competition uses a light stamping, susceptible to wear); 36,000 miles between chassis suspension and steering lubrications (competition requires this lubrication as often as every 6,000 miles); plus many lube-for-life features that require no lubrication for the life of the car provide the durability, economy and stamina to make Ford America's leader in police cars and "Boss of the Road".

Engineering and product features which provide quiet commanding power and versatility headline the Ford Station Wagons for 1969. Combine the choice of five "police packages" with an availability of three models-the Custom Ranch Wagon, the Custom 500 Ranch Wagon, and the Country Sedan-add exclusive features such as Ford's 3-way Magic Doorgate and you'll have a station wagon that will fill all of the needs of your department.

Ford has set the pace for versatile station wagon design, first with the 2-way and now the 3-way Magic Doorgate which may be quickly opened as a door with the window up for passengers and emergencies, or down as a tailgate for cargo.

Fold the second seat into the floor with a simple push button release and you have a full 96.2 cubic feet of cargo space that's more than 7½ feet long-even with the tailgate

Ford Wagon interiors are furnished in longwearing vinyl that is easy to maintain and keep clean. The load floors are textured steel covered with a scuff-resistant vinyl base paint. Optional rubber mats or load floor carpets are available.

Ford's long 121-inch wheelbase and 217-inch overall length coupled with a wide 63-inch front and 64-inch rear track and improved road-hugging suspension are designed to give a remarkable degree of riding comfort and command in handling.

All police package station wagons feature rugged heavyduty components and 8.55 x 15 BSW Nylon tires on heavyduty 6.5-inch safety rim wheels as standard and are available with a wide selection of options which allows you to select a Ford Wagon to your specific requirements.





Their exclusive Twin-I-Beam front suspension is matched to a long 105.5-inch or 123.5-inch wheelbase to give you carlike handling with a body length and weight distribution to suit your department's needs. Front and rear tread widths of over 5½ feet provide unsurpassed road stability and, because front wheels can turn sharply, you can maneuver quickly and easily in traffic or on the highway. Club Wagons are ideal for light personnel carriers and can transport groups of men quickly and conveniently. They are available with seating arrangements for 5, 8, or 12 passengers,


transport groups of men quickly and conveniently. They are available with seating arrangements for 5, 8, or 12 passengers, and 9 passengers with a table—an ideal "police command post" arrangement. All rear seats can be removed with simple hand tools to convert the Club Wagon to a two-passenger vehicle with maximum load space.

The use of Ford's "Twin-I-Beam" front suspension provides solid I-Beam durability and ruggedness with high quality ride of double-acting shock absorbers and coil spring suspension. This exclusive suspension system provides easier steering on turns, better stability on the highway, lower maintenance costs and longer tire life. The optional 302 V-8 is available to handle the maximum payloads up to 3,540 pounds, substantially higher than any in the industry. Widetrack axles contribute to greater vehicle stability and make



CLUTCHES AND TRANSMISSION

Clutches in Police Packages have thick facings and high-capacity pressure-plate springs. All are semi-centrifugal. Face diameter and frictional area is 11.0" (113.1 square inches).

3-Speed Manual Transmission is fully synchronized in all forward speeds, has hardened and shot-peened alloy-steel helical gears, and forged bronze synchronizers. Police Package with manual transmission includes heavy-duty shift linkage.

Select-Shift Cruise-O-Matic Drive is a required option in the Interceptor and Cruiser Police Package and is optional in the Guardian, Sentinel or Deputy Police Packages. The Interceptor Cruise-O-Matic is specially-calibrated for upshifts at higher rpm.

REAR AXLE

Police Package Heavy-Duty Axle is semi-floating type with deepoffset hypoid gears and straddle-mounted drive pinion. Also included are higher capacity wheel bearings with larger diameter axle shafts. Lubricator-fitted universal joints. For axle ratios see page 11.

ELECTRICAL

The electrical system is 12-volt with a 42-ampere alternator. Interceptor and Cruiser Police Packages have 80 ampere-hour 78-plate heavy-duty battery. Guardian, Sentinel, and Deputy Police Packages have 70-ampere hour 66 plate heavy-duty battery. Weatherproof ignition system with Static-Ban constant-resistance wiring and aircooled distributor points; positive-engagement starter.

SUSPENSION

Front—Wide 63-inch tread; ball-joint short and long arm suspension with drag strut stabilized lower arm anchored in anti-harsh compliant rubber bushings. Ball joints packed with 36,000-mile lubricant retained by full-life seals. Rubber-bushed stabilizer bar helps control sway on turns. Tapered roller wheel bearings with 30,000-mile check interval (repack as required). Specially calibrated shock absorbers with all-weather fluid for better year-round control. Shock absorbers sea-leg-mounted to resist body side-shake, have all-weather fluid for more uniform ride control. Police Package—Has heavy-duty coil springs and shock absorbers. The Interceptor package has a rear stabilizer bar to help resist roll on turns.

STEERING

Precision-control low-friction recirculating-ball type steering gear with anti-friction bearings throughout for easier steering. Flexible coupling in steering shaft insulates steering wheel; symmetrical linkage with nylon bearings in tie rod and pitman arm pivots packed with 36,000-mile lubricant retained by full-life seals. Overall steering ratio 30.8 to 1; with power steering, 21.8 to 1.

BRAKES

Dual hydraulic system with dual master cylinders provides independent brake system to front and rear wheels. Power front disc/ heavy-duty rear drum brakes included in the Interceptor Police Package and optional on others. Police Package Heavy-Duty Brakes, standard on the Cruiser, Guardian, Sentinel and Deputy, have 225 square-inch riveted linings and specially grooved 11" diameter composite drums for maximum cooling and fade resistance. Foot operated parking brake with hand release under panel.
