









HOW DID WE DESIGN SO MUCH COMFORT AND DURABILITY INTO SUCH A NEAT LITTLE WAGON?

Bobcat Villager—just one quick glance tells you it's from the same people who created the Continental Mark IV and the Mercury Colony Park. The look is trim and practical, yet stylish. From full-length simulated rosewood paneling on the outside, to thick-pile carpeting and handsomely tailored bucket seats on the inside, this little wagon was designed to be big on comfort and durability! Even the cargo floor is handsomely carpeted.



But there's a lot more to Villager than just show. This is a real working wagon, as a light flip of its counterbalanced liftgate will prove. A warning system alerts you when the liftgate is unintentionally left open. There's cargo space aplenty, 57.6 cubic feet of it, with the rear seat folded down, room enough to haul lots of gear! Great for chores and cross-country tours—rugged and durable.


On the road, Bobcat Villager is as lithe and as quick as its name. Self-adjusting front disc brakes are standard. The standard 2300 cc overhead cam engine delivers a power punch that neatly combines brisk perfor-

mance with welcome economy. Rackand-pinion steering, dual ball-joint front suspension, a cat-sure wide stance and stagger-mounted rear shock absorbers to give you the solid, sure, yet easy ride you expect from Mercury, the ride specialists.

The Villager interior, shown left, in addition to its surprising roominess and smart looks, is a commitment to comfort and quiet ride, thanks to generous sound deadening insulation applied to critical body areas and in the engine compartment. Standard trim is rich all-vinyl, offered in black or tan solid decor, and in two-tone blue or green and in orange and black. An optional interior in smart polyknit fabric and vinyl is also available, in blue, green or tan. The low-backed bucket seats are equipped with adjustable head restraints; the cargo floor carpeting, as throughout, is color-keyed.

Options? The list is a long one, ranging from 2.8 litre V-6 engine to roof luggage rack and including Select-Shift automatic transmission, air conditioning, AM/FM stereo radio, rear window electric defroster, and much more–even power brakes and power steering. See page 11 for the complete rundown.

Like its companion Bobcat Runabout, the Villager, in addition to economy of operation and easy maintenance, has been built to give you welcome dependability and durability,




and the full complement of Ford Motor Company Lifeguard Design Safety Features, just as are found on the big Mercurys.








NOW THE BIG CAT HAS A SPORTY LITTLE COUSIN WITH ITS OWN KIND OF SPIRIT AND STYLE!

Bobcat Runabout—our first three-door Mercury! We wanted to offer you a little Mercury that would be easy to drive and economical to maintain, without giving up the kind of comfort and fine detail you expect from Lincoln-Mercury.

And what a practical, versatile little car this is! With the rear seat up, it's a run-around-town car that carries four adult passengers in style. With one hand, release the rear seat fold-down latch and you convert your Runabout



into a frisky little "wagon" ready for fun and able to carry the gear—from tennis equipment and fishing rods to outboard motor and skis. The pneumatically assisted rear liftgate makes loading easy: lift it up and it stays out of the way. With the rear seat folded forward you reveal a full five feet of carpeted cargo floor.

The ride is smooth, quiet, and widestanced. The dual ball-joint suspension design is the same type as on our big cars. A 2300 cc engine performs with excellent gas mileage. Based on EPA dynamometer tests on this type of car with frequently purchased options, this standard engine delivers 24 to 29 mpg



under highway conditions; 17 to 19 under city conditions: Mileage will vary with equipment and type of driving. Sound deadeners and body insulation are used extensively, full length along the floor, for instance. Even the underside of the hood is blanketed in glass fiber to help quiet the engine. Manual front disc brakes and rack-and-pinion steering contribute to Bobcat's handling ease.

Inside, Bobcat goes all out for your comfort. Body-contoured bucket seats in durable solid or two-tone vinyl are standard; plush carpeting is color-keyed. Backrests have been designed to give comfortable support as you drive. For even more elegant decor, select the optional Polyknit fabric interior, shown left, available in blue, green or tan. Enjoy the extra richness of Bobcat's simulated woodgrain instrument panel, deluxe seat and door trim and low-back bucket seat design with adjustable head restraints.

The Runabout, too, boasts a wide selection of fine options to help you personalize your car (see page 11). They range from a Sunroof, forged aluminum wheels and steel-belted radial tires to a Sports Accent Group including leather-wrapped steering wheel, trim rings, thick cut-pile carpeting, "super sound" insulation package and special accent color on bodysides and lower back panel.





However you equip your Bobcat Runabout, you'll find it a sporty little cousin to the big cat and a handsome alternative to the traditional "Plain Jane" small car.


