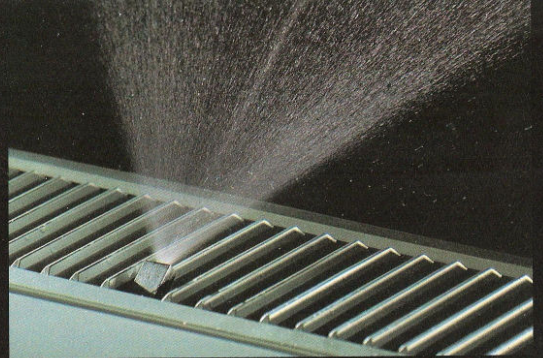

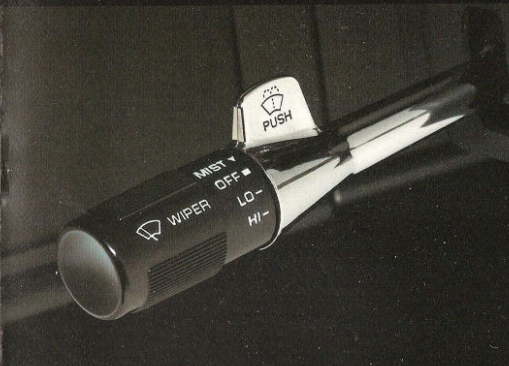

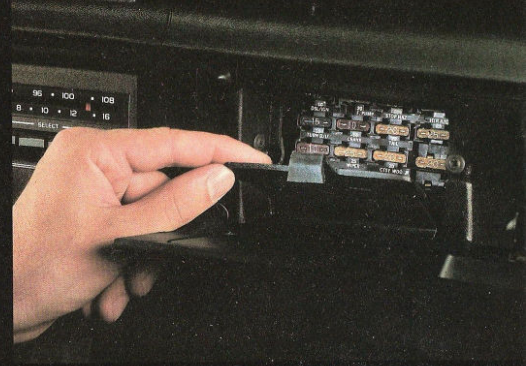

AN IN-DEPTH LOOK AT THE EXCITING '82 PONTIAC 6000 LE

- 1 Electronic Fuel Injection on the 2.5 liter 4-cylinder engine provides quick starting, impressive fuel economy, automatic altitude adjustment and smooth, steady acceleration.
- 2 MacPherson strut front suspension has specially isolated coil springs for a quiet, precise ride.
- 3 Rack and pinion power steering delivers quick response with good road feel.
- 4 Match mounted wheels and tires help provide Pontiac 6000's smooth ride.
- 5 Single stamped front "A" pillar helps reduce vibration.
- 6 Dual fluidic windshield washers provide generous cleaning of the windshield in bad weather.
- 7 Roof rail is bonded to the outer roof panel for sound dampening and improved overall structure with less road noise.
- 8 Available handsome center console with built-in cassette storage box and handy coin holder.
- 9 Extended range speakers are included with available Delco-GM stereos.
- 10 Full coil suspension features special sound insulators for more effective road isolation.
- 11 Wraparound sheet metal, front and rear, reduces fit lines for a more elegant appearance.

The Pontiacs described in this brochure are assembled at facilities of General Motors Corporation operated by Pontiac, GM Assembly Division or GM of Canada. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by various divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce Pontiac products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Pontiac products and will provide the quality performance associated with the Pontiac name.
