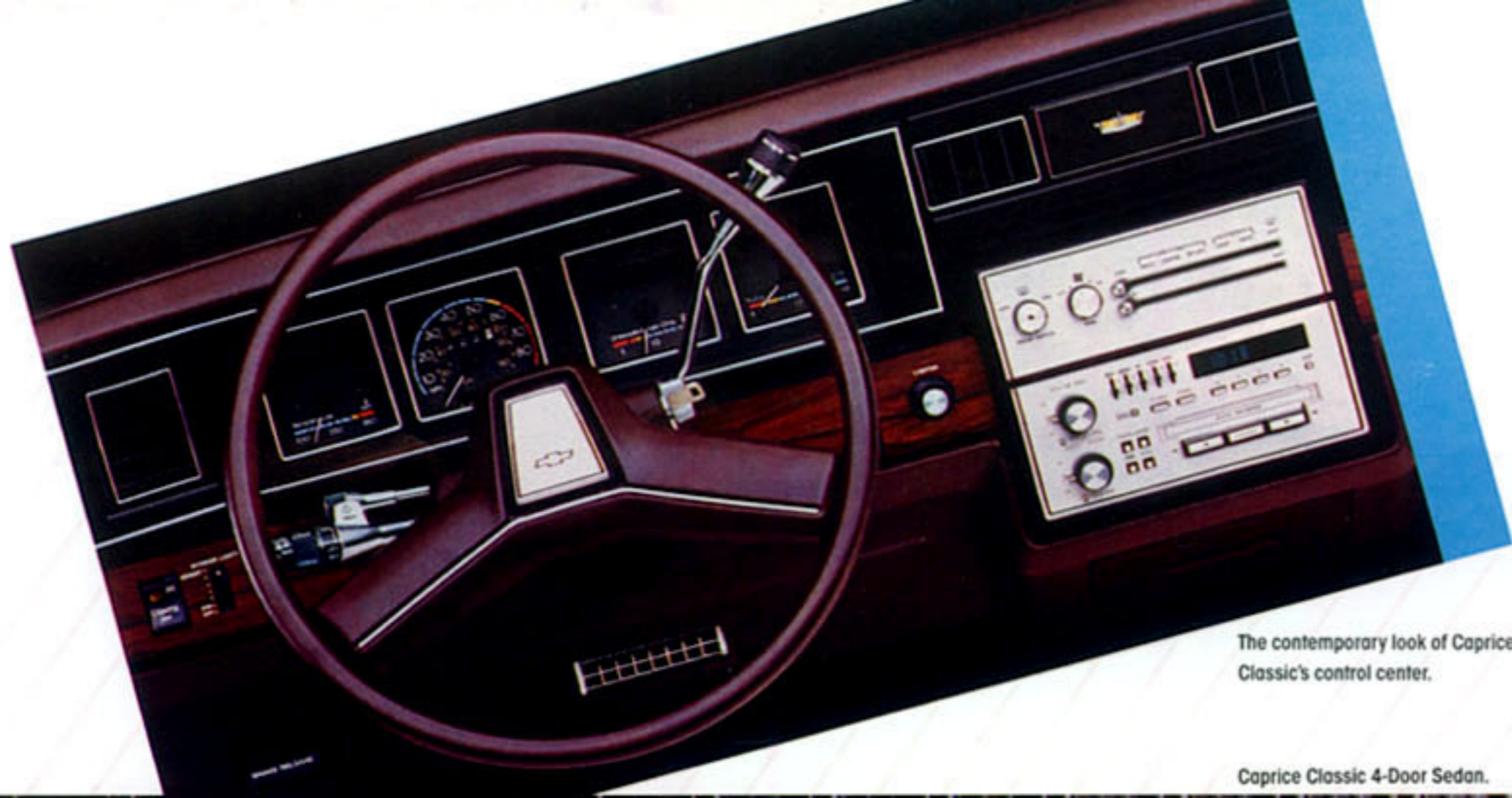

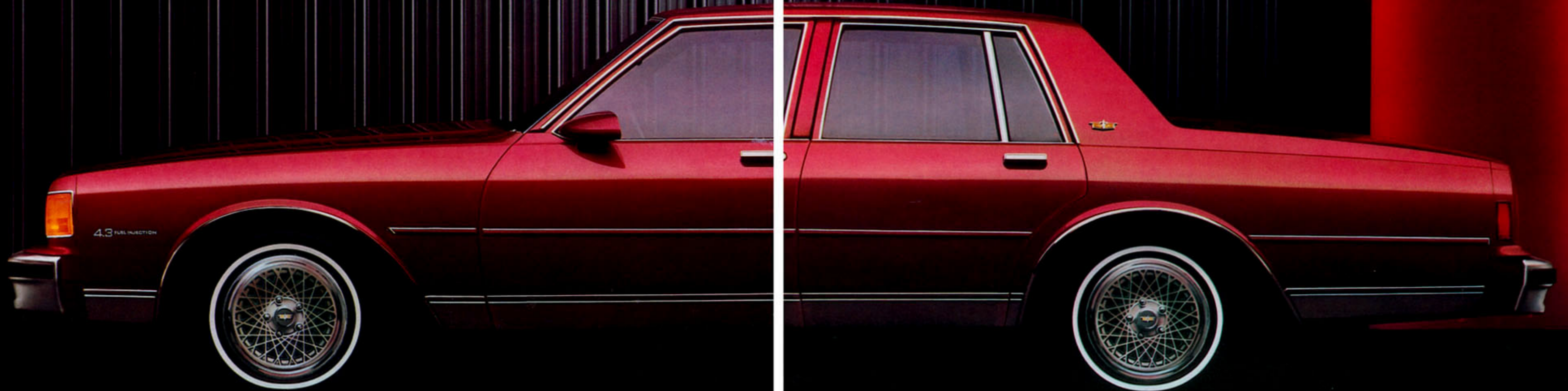

and convenience that's harder to find than a clean-faced five-year-old.

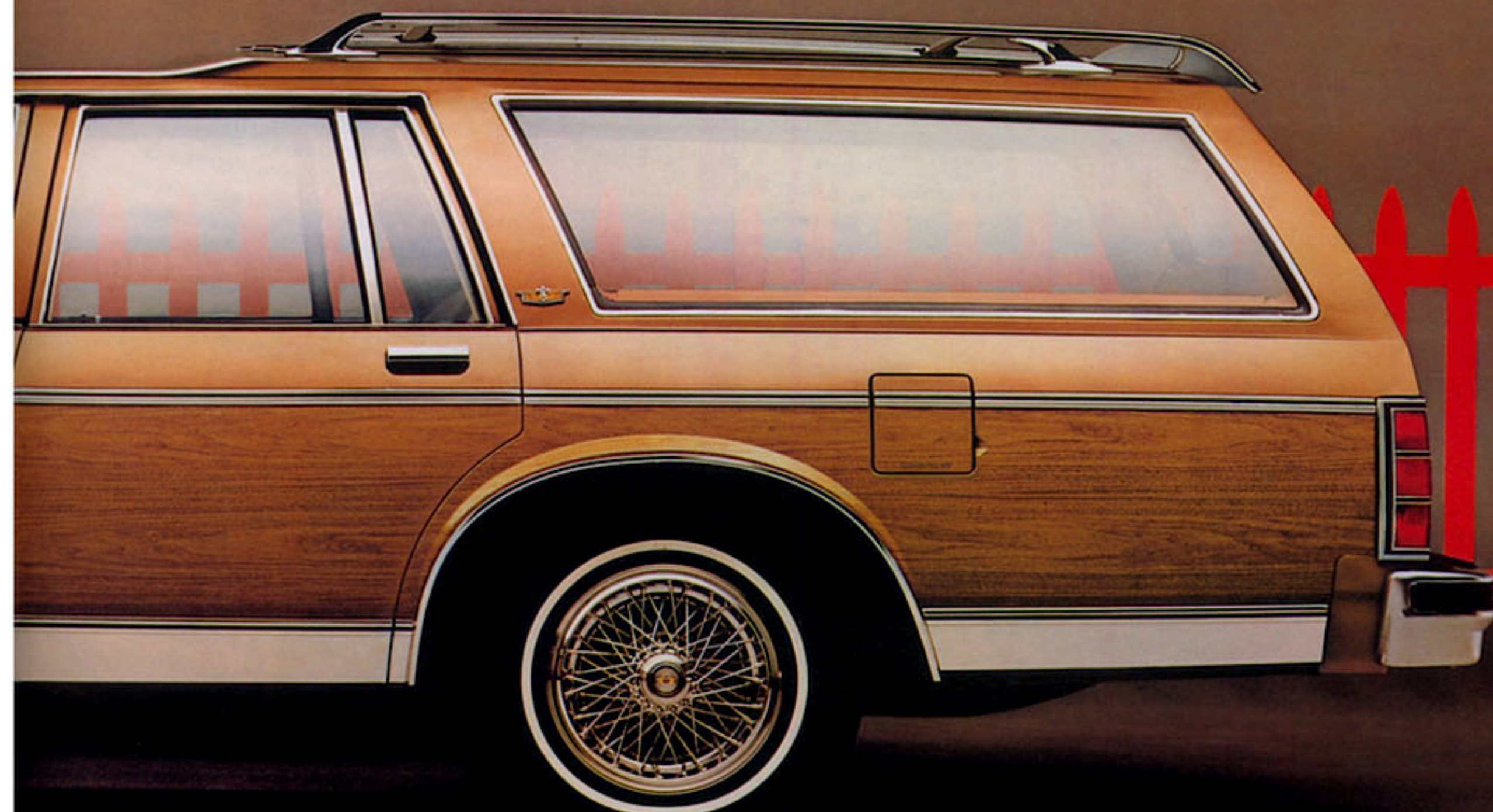
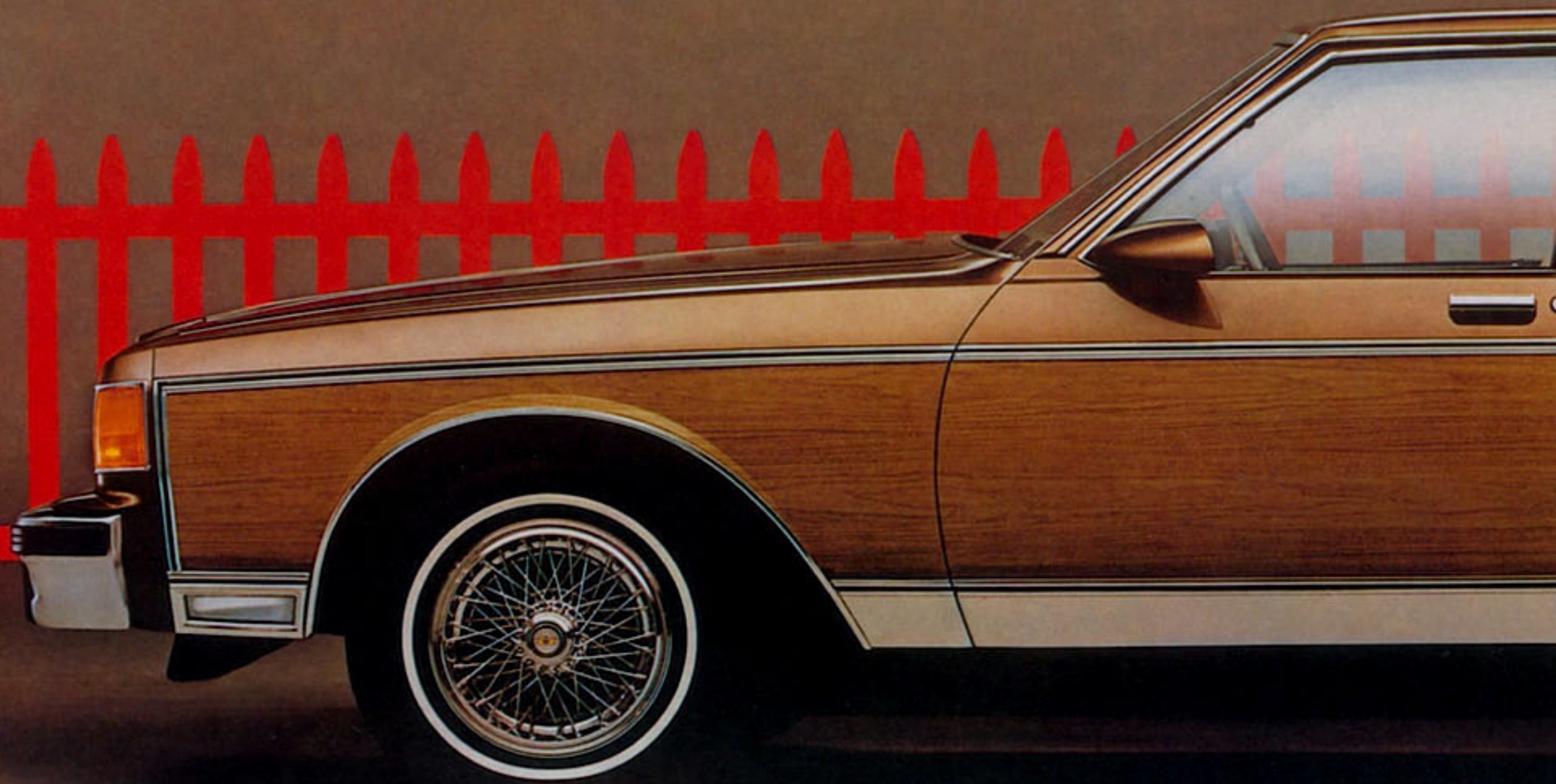
