NOVA SUPER SPORT

Here's sporty going at its Chevy II best. Just look inside this one. That all-new brushed-chrome center console will catch your eye at once. You get it when you order 4-Speed Synchro-Mesh transmission with new floor-mounted control lever or Powerglide with new straight-line shift. (Steering-column-mounted 3-Speed shift is standard.) Look further: front bucket seats with color-keyed seat belts; textured all-vinyl trim; functional instrumentation with ammeter, oil pressure and engine temperature gauges and an electric clock with sweep second hand. Also, SS nameplate on the glove box; carpeted floors and more.

Not forgetting the ladies, six smart interior color combinations are available: fawn, aqua, red, blue, saddle and black. Even three special exterior colors: Evening Orchid, Glacier Gray and Crocus Yellow (in addition to an extensive color list of 12 solids and selected two-tones). Up front, parking lamps are relocated in the deep-section bumper for maximum visibility. Sporty wheel covers are standard. And under the hood, the Super Sport Coupe has the power to please with standard power in the 120-hp Six or 195-hp V8, depending on the model version you choose. Or you can specify extra horsepower, and plenty of it, in the 140-hp Turbo-Thrift 230 six or the Turbo-Fire 327 V8s with horsepower ratings of 250 and 300.

Both the 4-cylinder engine and the 6-cylinder engines feature short-stroke design with overhead valves; compression ratio of 8.5:1; quiet hydraulic valve lifters; full-pressure lubricating system, full-flow oil filter; positive crankcase ventilation; single-barrel carburetor (manual choke in the Four; automatic in the Sixes) and oil-wetted polyurethane-clement air cleaner. Both have rugged crankshafts, 5 replaceable main bearings in the Four; 7 replaceable main bearings in the Sixes.

The V8s feature short-stroke design with overhead valves; quiet hydraulic valve lifters; efficient wedge-type combustion chambers; compression ratio of 9.25:1 in standard V8, 10.5:1 in 327 V8s; 2-barrel carburetor (4-barrel in 327 V8s) with automatic choke and oil-wetted paper-element air cleaner; full-flow oil filter; positive crankcase ventilation; rugged crankshaft with five replaceable main bearings.

BODY BY FISHER/Every '65 Chevy II features Body by Fisher; integral body-and-frame design and unitized front end, thoroughly sealed and insulated; bolt-on front fenders; high-level coil ventilation through dual vents in front compartment kick panel (individual knob controls for each); rheostat-controlled lighted instrument cluster including dial speedometer; odometer; fuel gauge; oil pressure, engine temperature and generator indicator lights (replaced by instruments plus clock in Nova Super Sport). New accessory position on ignition switch permits use of auxiliary equipment without unnecessary drain on battery. Four-position switch identified left to right as follows: Accessory, Off, On, Start. Key is removable in "Off" position only. Turn signals and indicator light; locking glove box. Trunk lid, hood and wagon tailgate are counterbalanced. Fifteen Magic-Mirror colors: Tuxedo Black, Kremlin White, Mist Blue, Danube Blue, Willow Green, Cypress Green, Artesian Turquoise, Tahitian Turquoise, Madeira Maroon, Regal Red,
