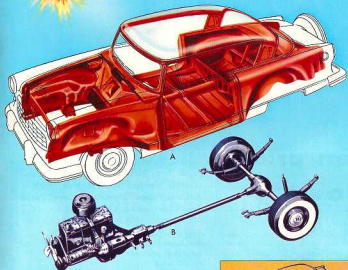

The engine, transmission, and Hotchkiss drive line assembly (B) is secured to the independently rigid unit body structure. The simplicity and complete integration of Double Strength Unit Body Construction are shown graphically by a comparison of the Rambler method (above) with the conventional method (right).

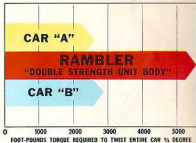
