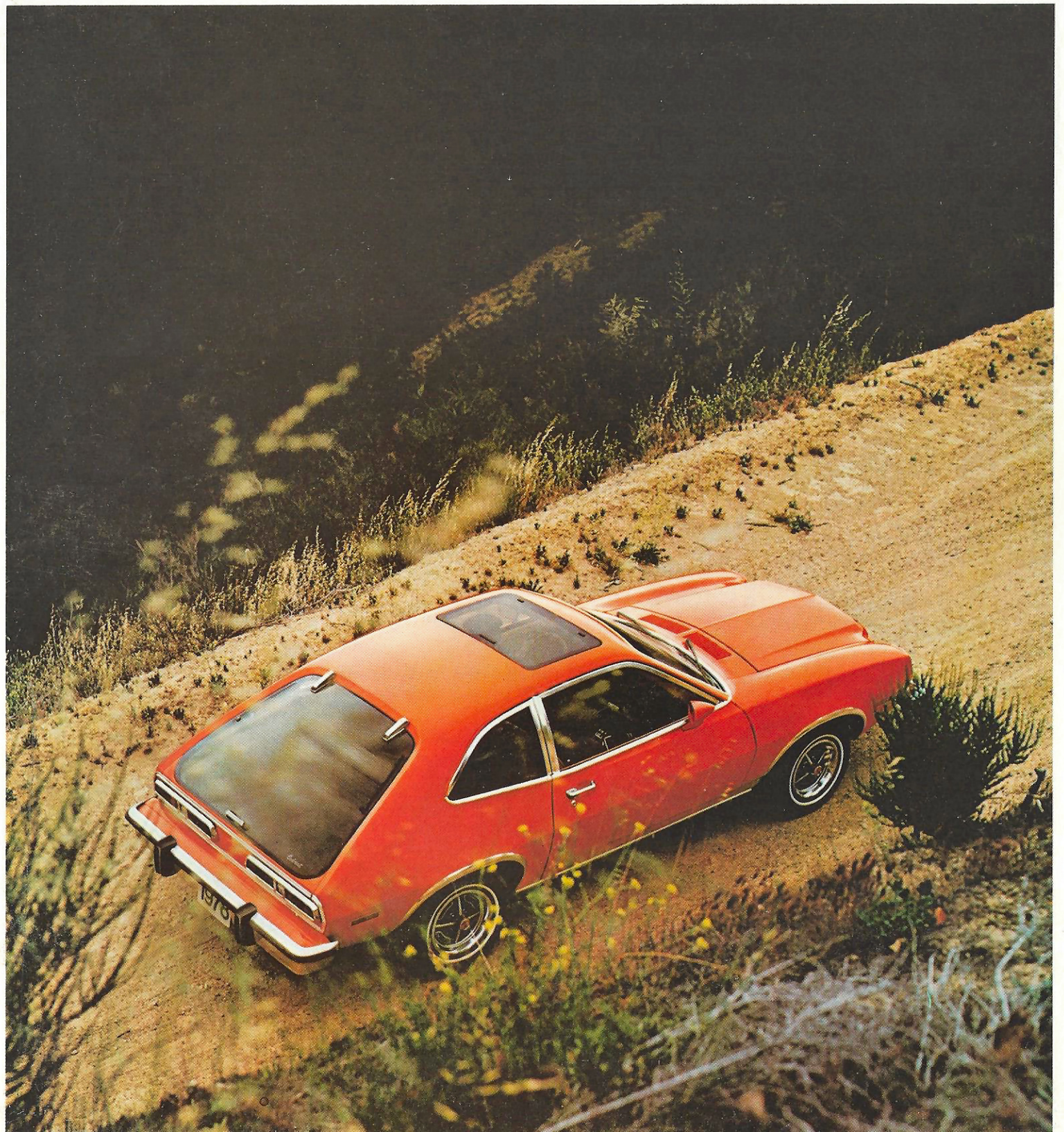

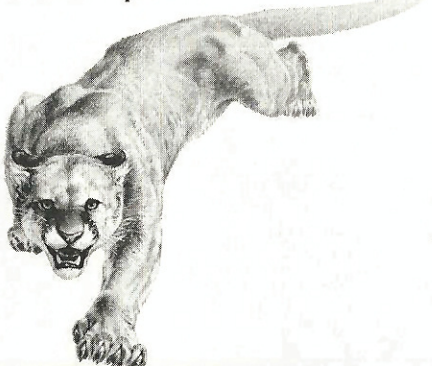

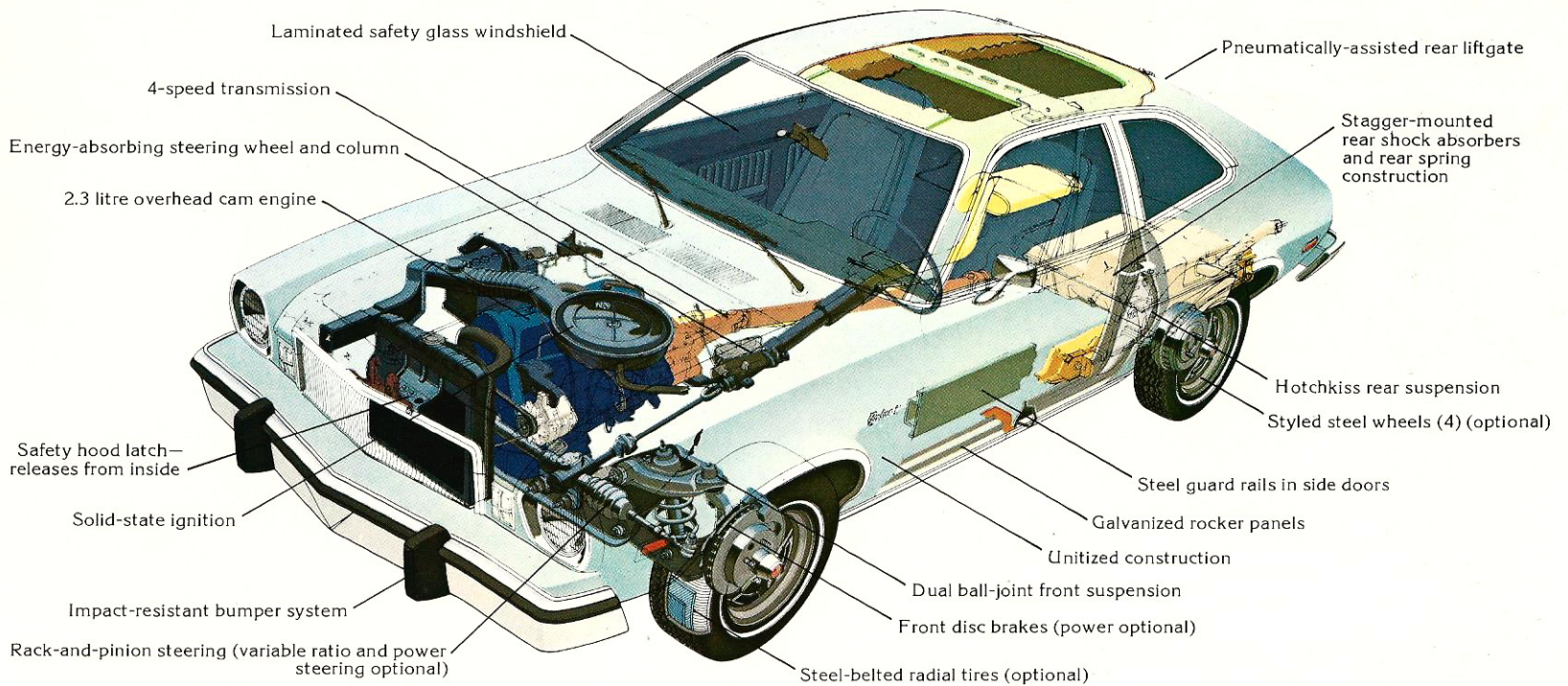

The Mercury Bobcat Villager Wagon (shown above), the Bobcat Wagon and the Bobcat 3-door Runabout. Smartly styled, Bobcat offers features that you might not expect in a car at its price. Bobcat comes equipped with rack-and-pinion steering . . . deep, padded bucket seats . . . generous sound insulation . . . front disc/rear drum brakes . . . a popular 2.3 litre overhead cam "four" engine plus a long list of standard features. 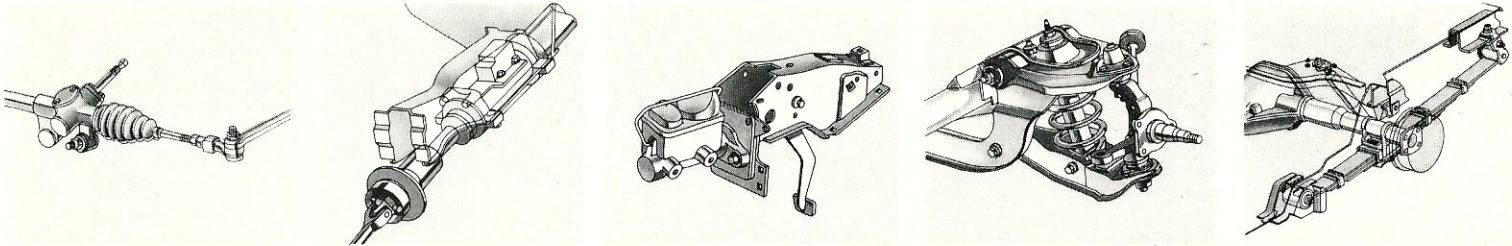
The list of options available on Bobcat is long and varied. (See back cover.) Everything from a flip-up/removable

Ford Motor Company 75th Anniversary—Ford Motor Company was in its 35th year when the first Mercury automobile was introduced on November 4, 1938. This was the very beginning of the Lincoln-Mercury fine car division. The 1938 Mercury was the first Ford-produced car styled entirely within the company and the first built up from a clay model by Ford stylists. The Lincoln-Mercury Division is proud of its contribution to Ford Motor Company's illustrious history. Just as we are proud of the fine products in this book that are a part of the heritage of Ford Motor Company.

MERCURY BOBCAT: A FUN-TO-DRIVE CAR.

Bobcat was thoroughly engineered from the ground up. The cutaway above is designed to point out some of the features that combine to make Bobcat a pleasure to own.

Unitized body construction—Bobcat has an all-steel unitized body. The sheet metal and structural members are all solidly welded to the underbody platform to form a completely unitized construction that helps provide excellent alignment of doors, hood and third door.

Rack-and-pinion steering—Bobcat offers rack-and-pinion steering like that of many expensive European sports cars. It provides positive, precise response. The rack housing

is mounted on the front crossmember and linked by tie rods to the steering arms ahead of the front wheel centers. And Bobcat '78 offers optional variable ratio power steering.

Hydraulic brake system—Bobcat is equipped with a dual hydraulic braking system with warning light, one of many Ford Motor Company Lifeguard Design Safety Features.

Energy-absorbing steering column—Another of Bobcat's Ford Motor Company Lifeguard Design Safety Features is its energy-absorbing steering column and steering wheel.

Staggered mounting shocks. Rear shock absorbers on Bobcat are angle mounted to slant inward to maximize ride control. Large rubber bushings

are used in mounting the shocks to help control noise, vibration and harshness levels.

The Bobcat Runabout is designed for versatility. With the rear seat up, it's a sporty car with room and comfort for four passengers. With one hand, release the rear seat fold-down latch and you convert your Bobcat to a cargo-carrier able to carry all your gear from fishing rods to skis. The pneumatically assisted rear liftgate makes loading easy: lift it up and it stays out of the way. With the rear seat folded forward, you have a full five feet of cargo length load space. Bobcat is a car that solves a lot of problems.

Bobcat is designed for maneuvering on the highway and in city traffic. The 1978 Bobcat with its 2.3 litre engine and four-speed manual transmission, is a car with good fuel economy* at an affordable price.

And Bobcat offers you handsome exterior and interior styling in a small car. And interior room that spells comfort, as well as generous luggage carrying capacity. The Runabout offers 29 cubic feet of luggage capacity—the Bobcat Wagons over 57 cubic feet, with the rear seat folded down.

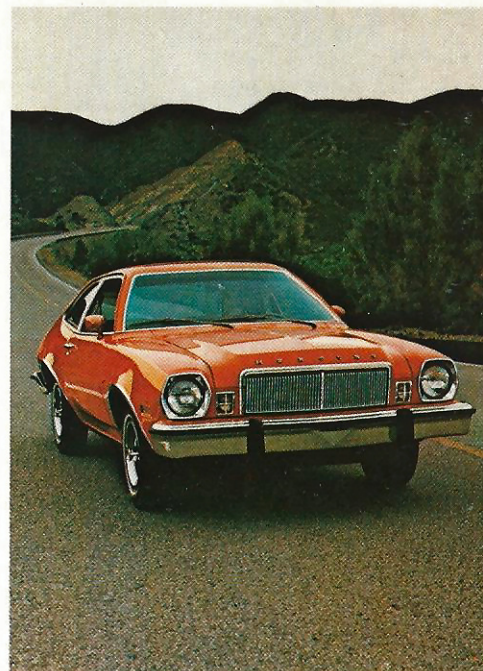

Bobcat is agile and easy to park, as you might expect. Its low, wide stance provides balance on turns and in crosswinds. And while it's the smallest Mercury, it's big on style. Bobcat's optional deluxe interior, shown, features all-vinyl low-back bucket seats in black, and is also available in bright red, Wedgewood blue, medium jade and chamois. The other optional deluxe interior shown below is tangerine Alpine cloth-and-vinyl. And how about that mini-console

shown below? Another thoughtful touch, standard in Bobcat, it's a convenient place to store those often-used items like sunglasses and maps.

Bobcat features an independent coil spring front suspension. Suspension components are attached to the body at rubber insulated mounting points. This helps minimize the transfer of road noise and vibration to the passenger compartment.

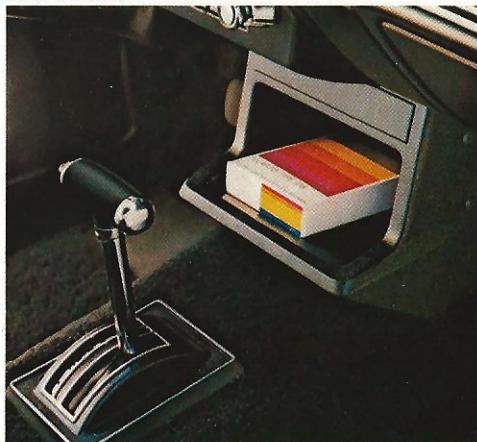
Bobcat's rear suspension features semi-elliptical multi-leaf springs which help resist side motion.



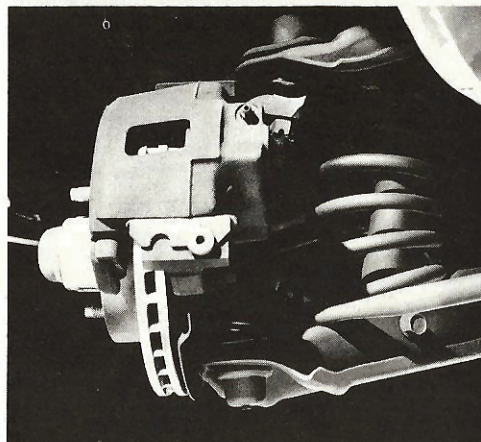

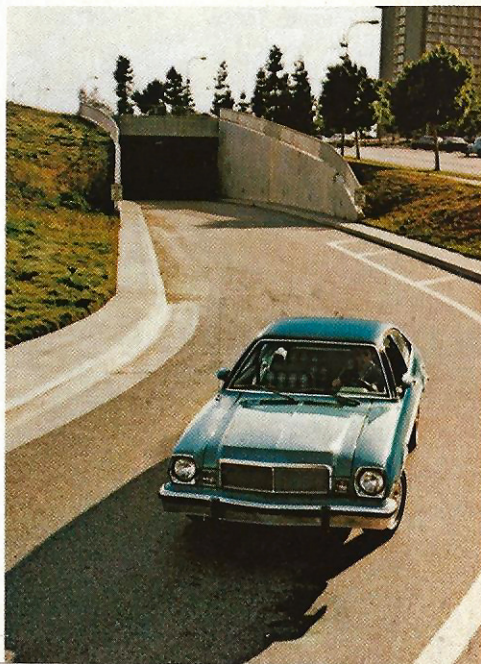

Bobcat offers two wagon models: the Bobcat Villager Wagon with simulated rosewood bodyside and tailgate appliques, and the Bobcat Wagon. Bobcat wagons feature a counter-balanced liftgate that opens with a simple flip of the wrist.

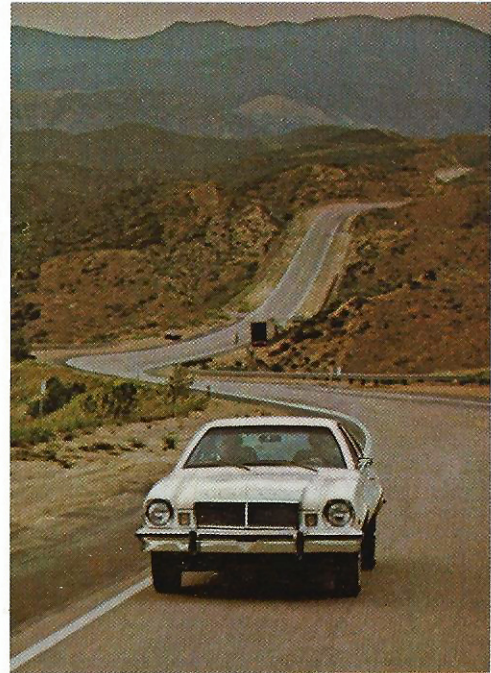
Bobcat's warning light system alerts you when the liftgate is unintentionally left open. And there's cargo space galore: 6 feet of load length for all manner of totables with the rear seat down. On the road, Bobcat is fun to drive. Self-adjusting front disc brakes are standard. And Bobcat comes equipped with the popular 2.3 litre overhead cam "four"

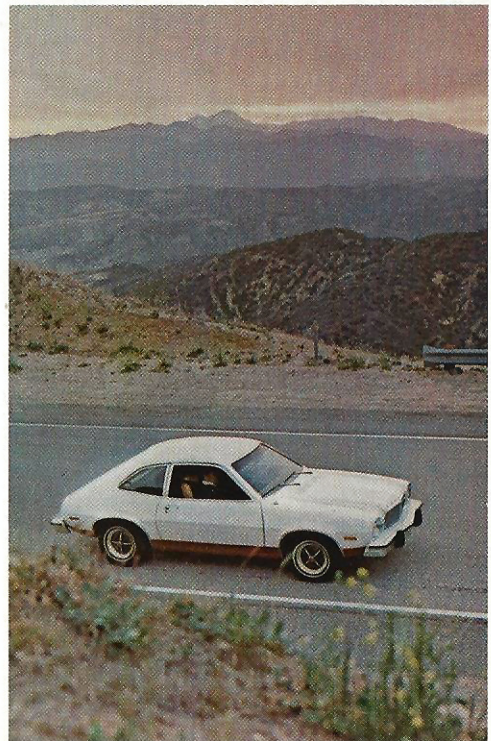

- Requires automatic transmission on all models, power brakes on wagons. Includes variable venturi carburetor in California. Not available with High Altitude Option.
- Required on 2.8 litre V-6 models.
- Includes tachometer, temperature gauge and ammeter; three spoke, soft-rim sports steering wheel; front stabilizer bar and higher axle ratio in Runabout equipped with 2.3 L engine.
- Includes day/night inside mirror, remote control racing mirrors, passenger visor vanity mirror, deluxe color-keyed seat belts, engine compartment light, glove box and ash tray lights, lights-on buzzer, adjustable map light, interval windshield wipers and 3rd door courtesy light switch.

- Includes sun screen and stowage bag. Available only on 3-door.
- Includes tri-color bodyside tape stripe with stylized Bobcat head on front fender, tri-color hood and lower back panel tape stripes, four white styled steel wheels, dual racing mirrors, front spoiler with integral air chutes, handling suspension, all-glass third door, black paint treatment to wiper arms, drip and window frames, belt areas and windshield moldings, black painted rocker panel. Power disc brakes required. Available on 3-door only.
- Includes lower bodyside and lower back panel paint/tape treatment (Runabout only), four styled steel wheels and trim rings, leather-wrapped sports steering wheel, deluxe low-back bucket seats, high-level seat and door trim, deluxe seat belts, sound package, gold color bodyside tape stripe (Villager only). Not available with Sports Package, Deluxe Interior Trim or Styled Steel Wheels.
