



Inside, Chevrolet innovations take many forms. For example, you can specify a steering wheel that tilts through seven positions. We call it "Comfortilt." You'll call it great. On many Chevrolet models you also




Chevrolet enthusiasts have made Chevelle America's no. 1 intermediate-size seller, and the SS 396 just has to be one of the reasons why. Up front under the unique hood is the 325-hp Turbo-Jet 396 V8.

Outside are SS 396 emblems and accents. Bench seats are standard or you can get bucket front seats. Transmissions? A fully synchronized Special 3-Speed is standard; 4-Speed, Powerglide or versatile Turbo Hydra-Matic (the automatic you also can shift yourself) may be specified.

If you're a lover of full-size sportiness, look to the Impala SS version of a custom coupe, sport coupe or convertible. You enjoy full wheel covers, Strato-bucket seats, sports console, special upholstery and SS identification.

Chevrolet's sporty Nova SS Coupe is the one that's capturing big new popularity this year. Order it and you get such specialties as 295-hp V8, louver-styled hood, special chassis components, black-accented grille, red stripe wide-oval tires, SS markings and deluxe steering wheel.





Of course, you can always depend on Chevrolet for leading power teams. Did you know that Chevrolet makes more kinds of engines than anyone? Of course, it is reasonable to expect innovation and variety in power teams as well as in style, ride and luxury. For starters Chevrolet and Chevelle have the widest choice of power teams in their fields. Chevrolet's standard 6-cylinder engine has the largest piston displacement (250 cubic inches) and the most horsepower (155) in its field. And this year, Chevrolet, Chevelle and Chevy Nova have a regular-fuel standard V8 of 307 cubic inches, the largest standard V8 ever for these cars. When you consider the range covered by Chevrolet's engines, it's truly staggering. Chevy Nova includes a 4-cylinder 90-hp engine,

and the air-cooled Corvair engines are all flat "pancake" sixes, with horsepower rating from 95 to 140. The latter is kind of special—with four single-barrel carburetors. V8 engine displacements are topped by the authoritative 427 Turbo-Jet engines, available in Chevrolet and Corvette. 396-cubic-inch versions can be ordered in Chevrolet, Chevelle and Camaro. In Corvette, the top output 435-hp Turbo-Jet 427 V8 features three 2-barrel carburetors, special performance camshaft and mechanical valve lifters.

As for transmissions, Chevrolet offers the lowest priced automatic transmission in its field, the favorite Powerglide. Depending on engine,

you can also specify the three-speed Turbo Hydra-Matic on Chevrolet, Chevelle and Camaro. Even Corvette is now available with Turbo Hydra-Matic, the transmission that offers manual select-the-gear-you-want feature or fully automatic operation.

For drivers who like to do their own precise shifting, all 3-Speeds are fully synchronized so you can shift into low without coming to a full stop. 4-Speed manuals are available with every V8 and with every Camaro and Corvair 6. If you like the economy of Overdrive, you may get this money saver with every 6 or standard V8 engine in Chevrolet or Chevelle.

Like traveling music? AM only, or AM/FM radios with or without FM stereo. You might like stereo tape to do your bidding for ultimate listening luxury.






