Room and comfort with the Cadillac touch. Cimarron's got it.

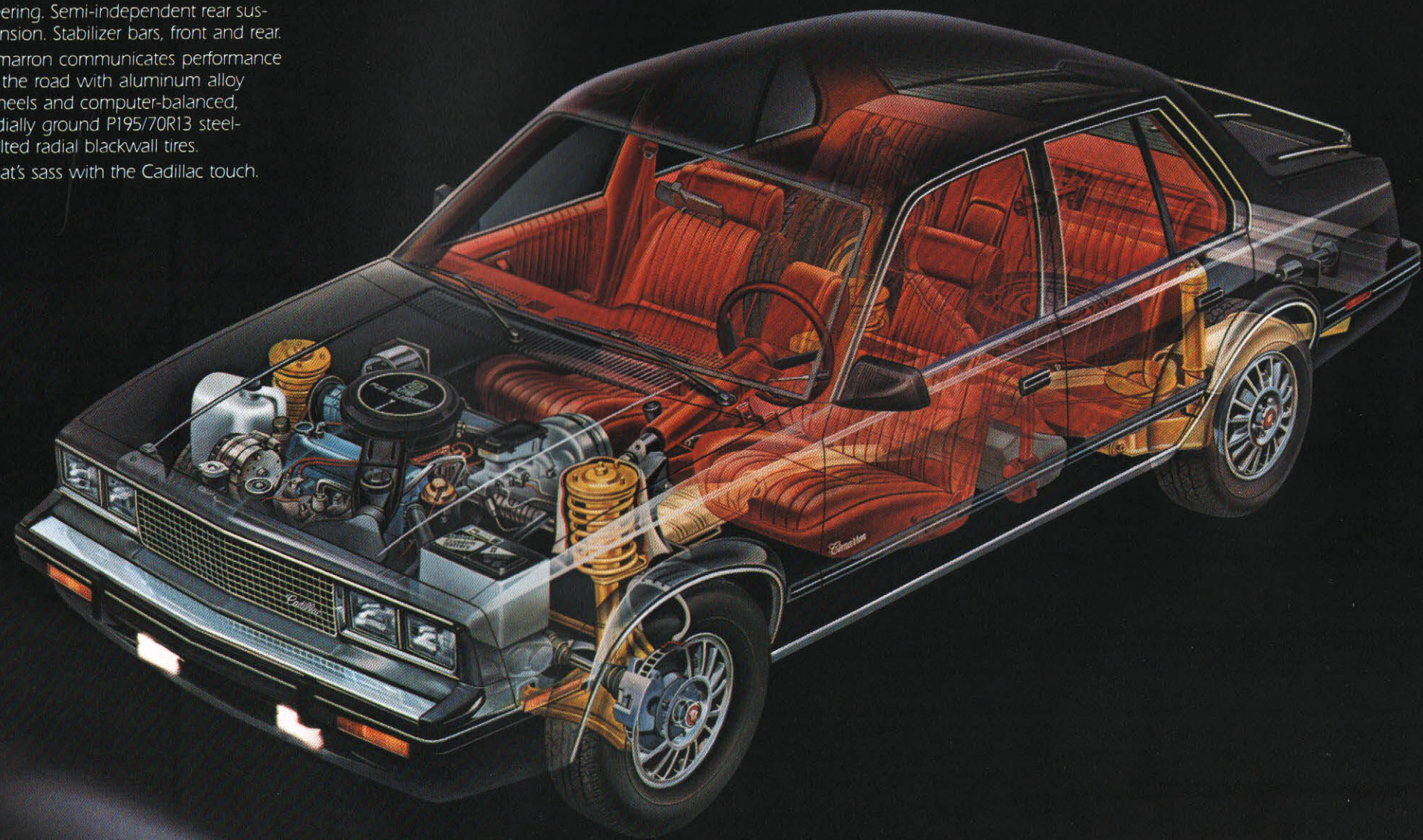
CIMARRON: PERFORMANCE

A VERY SPECIAL CIMARRON.

Gold accents distinguish the aluminum alloy wheels and grille. Blacked-out bumpers and smoke gray fog lamp covers state a subtle dechromed motif. It is the only Cimarron painted black. It's called the Cimarron D'Oro. Fine gold stripes accent the belt line, bumper rub strips and the center of the hood. Which leads the eye to D'Oro's unique hood ornament.

Supple saddle leather in seating areas is standard. There is a D'Oro plaque on the instrument panel. And the steering wheel is clearly a D'Oro creation, with gold-tinted spokes and horn pad emblem. Cimarron D'Oro. Its name on a plaque by each front door means gold. The ultimate Cadillac touch.
