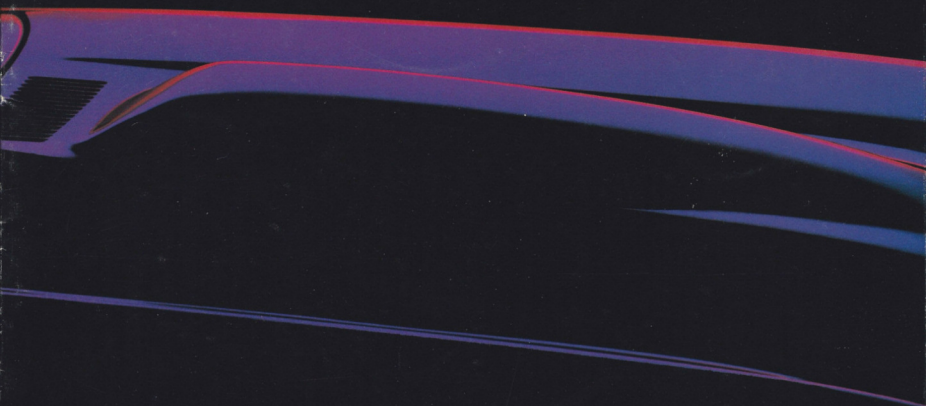

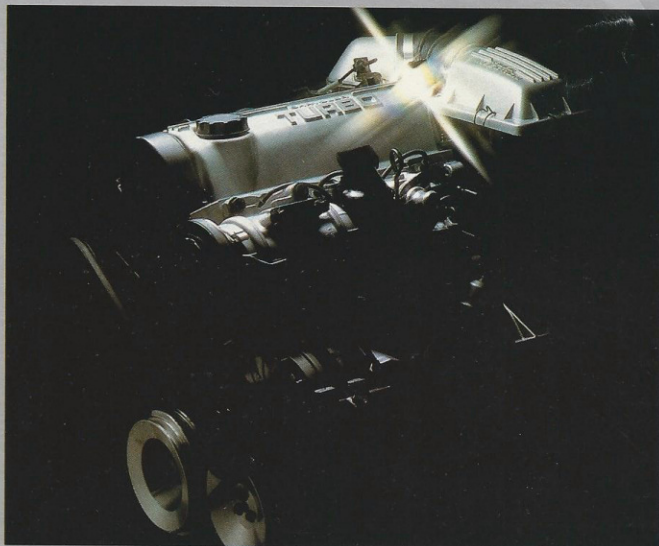

Power play.

Inside and outside the Shelby Charger you feel and sense the genius of Carroll Shelby. The adventure begins as you get behind the wheel and ignite the amazing 2.2-liter turbo-charged multipoint Chrysler/Bosch EFI engine with Garrett AiResearch T3 turbocharger. The muffled rumble of

the free-breathing performance exhaust system lets you know the excitement has begun.

Depress the throttle and experience a remarkable burst of power. Shelby bolts from 0 to 50 in a brisk 5.34 seconds.* At full throttle it cranks out an exhilarating 146 net horsepower at 5,200 rpm with a compression ratio of 8.1:1.

Shelby Charger conquers even the most serpentine road with race-stiffened shock and spring suspension and gas-charged front struts and rear shocks. Firm-feel 14:1 fast-ratio power-assisted rack-and-pinion

steering adds to your control.

Power-assisted ventilated front discs and larger rear drum brakes bring Shelby to a crisp, safe halt. Standard 15-inch cast aluminum wheels with Eagle GT radial tires add to adept handling, excellent traction.

If you need further proof of Shelby's credentials, check out the results of many of America's top professional races. You'll find the name Shelby

Charger up at the top of the list.

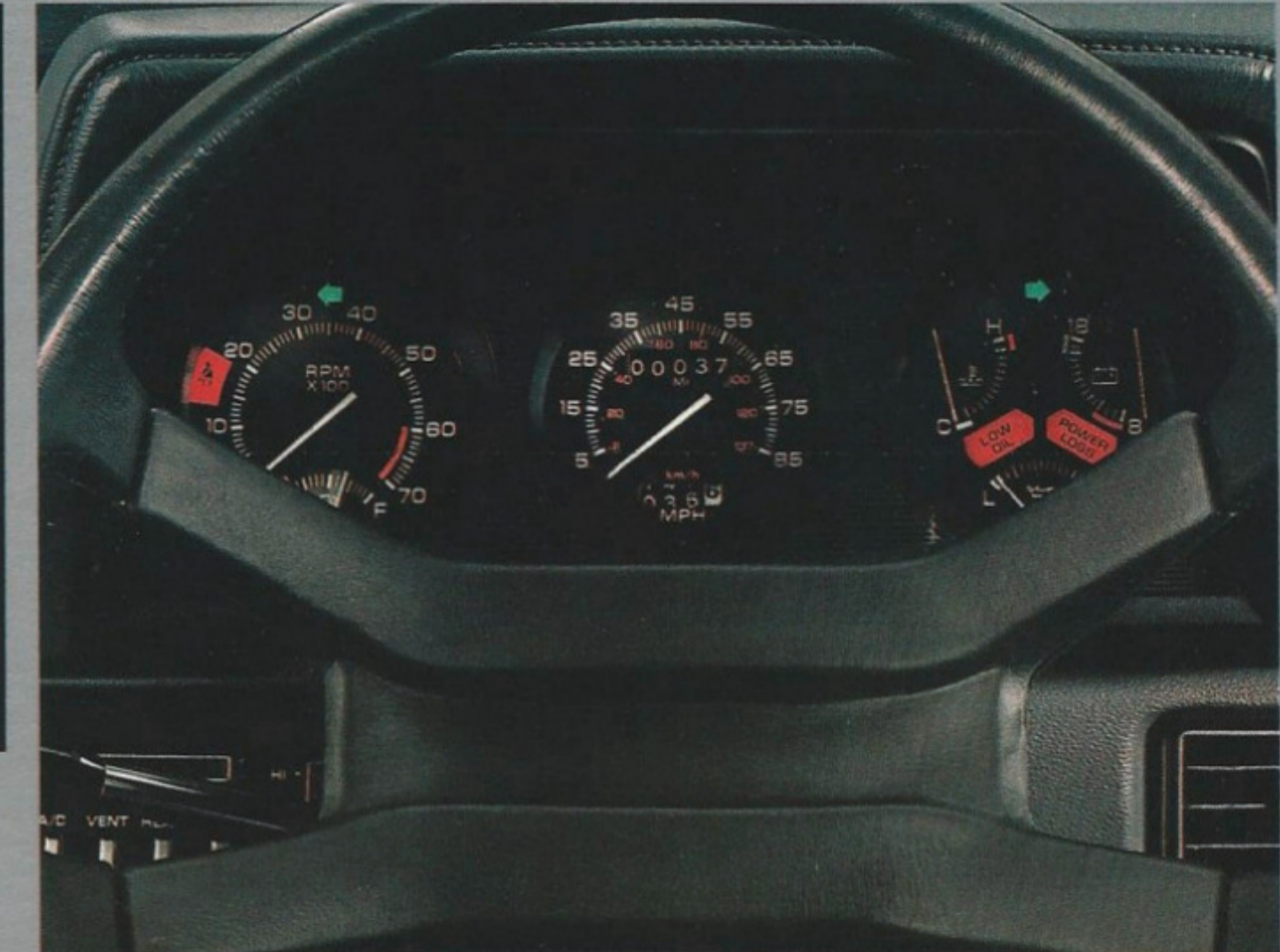
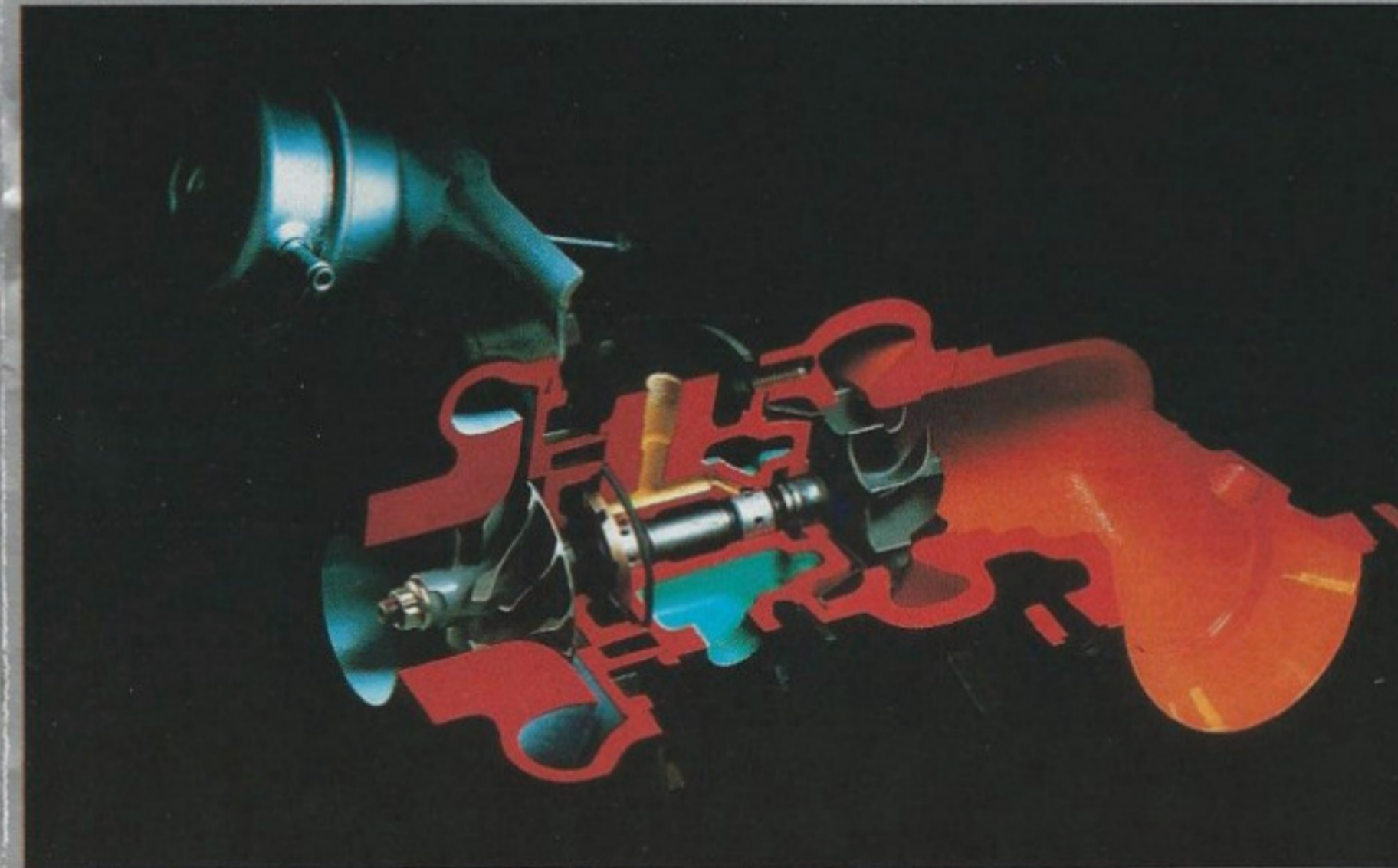

standard 2.2-liter high-performance engine and 5-speed manual trans-axle, Charger 2.2 delivers generous fun-to-drive mileage ratings of 22 EPA estimated city mpg, 30 estimated highway.

The base Charger is equipped with a 1.6-liter four-cylinder engine with standard four-speed manual overdrive

transaxle. This combination makes for an exceptional mileage rating of 31 EPA estimated city mpg, 39 estimated highway.

The optional 2.2-liter four-cylinder engine with five-speed manual overdrive transaxle gives excellent response to your every move.

Charger 2.2 has the performance look with a front air dam. Fender extensions. Side sill spoilers.

Bold graphics. Fourteen-inch Rallye road wheels and road-gripping steel-belted radial tires complete the sports car look and feel.

Charger and Charger 2.2 are loaded with standard features that contribute to ease of handling and cater to your comfort.

Power-assisted brakes, rack-and-pinion steering and road-hugging Iso-Strut independent front suspension ensure excellent handling.

Inside, your comfort and convenience take precedence. Contoured cloth with vinyl trim bucket seats with individually adjustable recliners are

A. AIR CONDITIONING*

Features a four-speed blower, four adjustable air outlets, upper level ventilation with maximum air conditioning for recirculating cool interior air.

C. SUN/SOUND/SHADE DISCOUNT PACKAGE

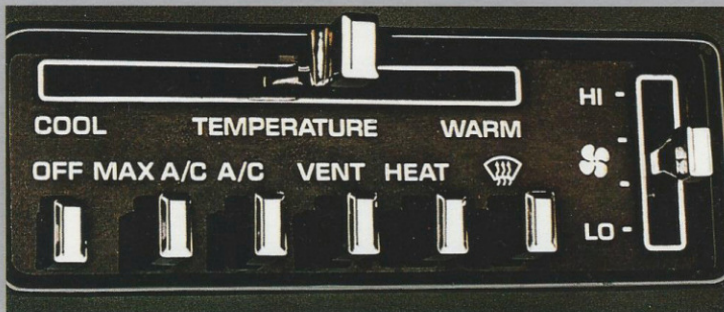

E. REAR WINDOW DEFROSTER

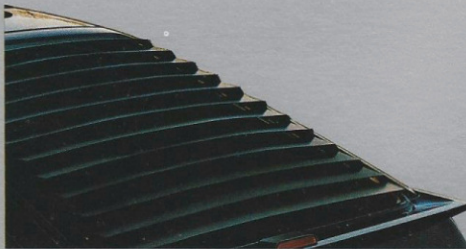
This electric option keeps your rear window clear of snow, ice, and fog. Whatever the weather, you'll have a good view of what's behind you.

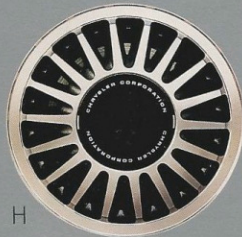
