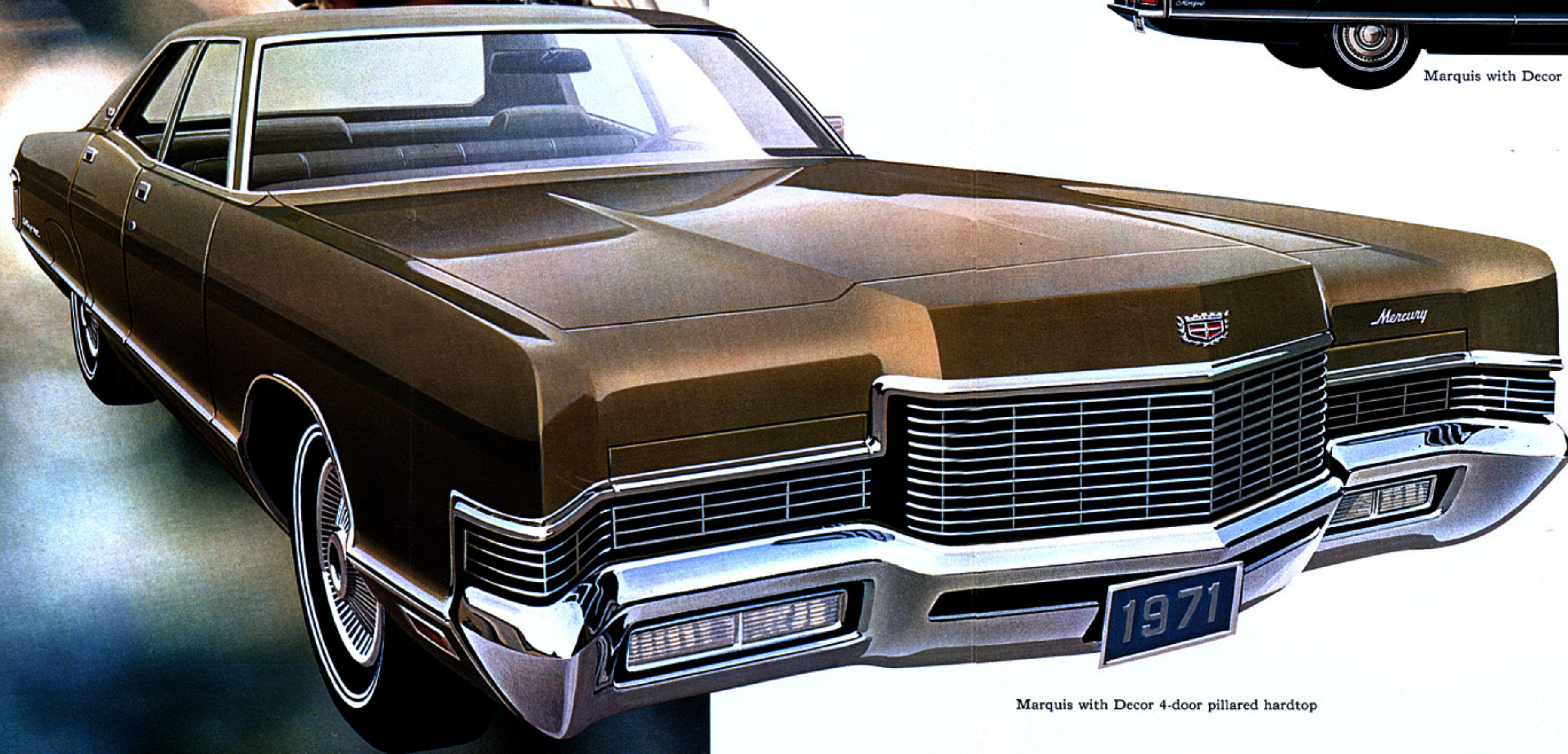
Marquis with Decor: drama and distinction in every line

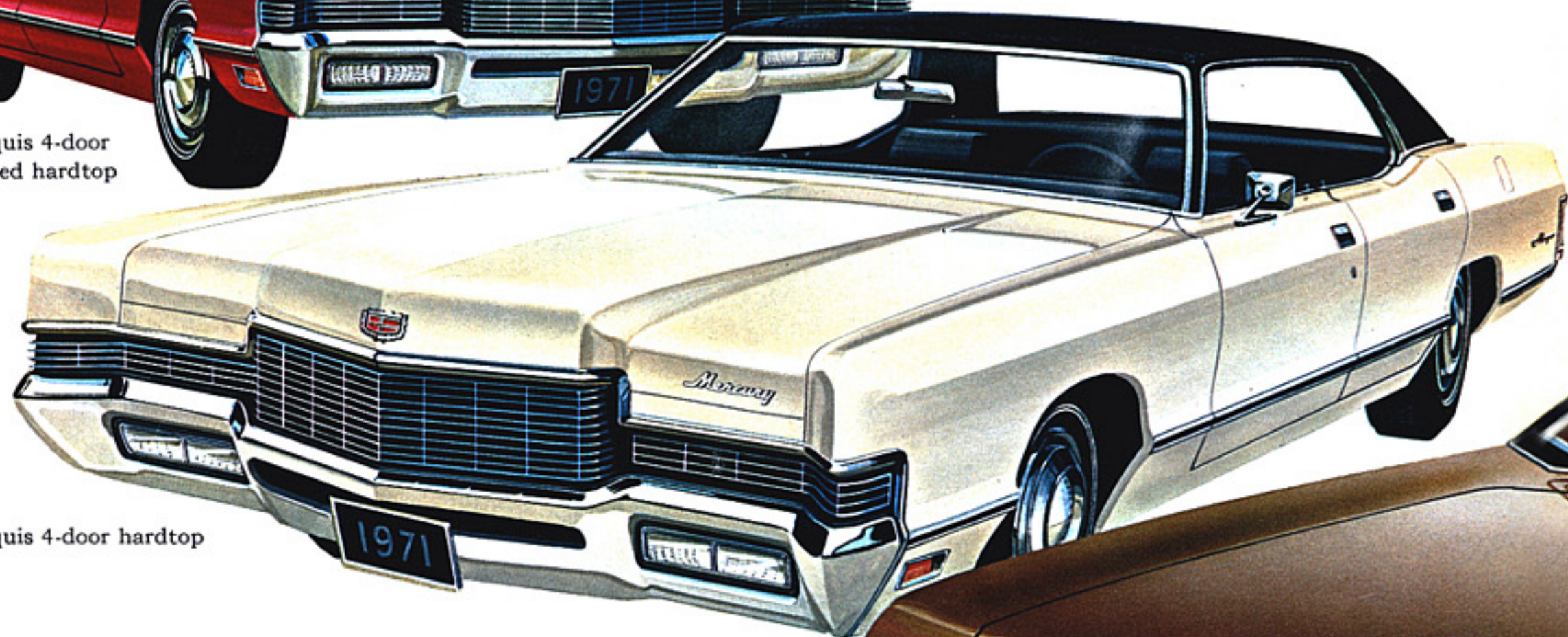

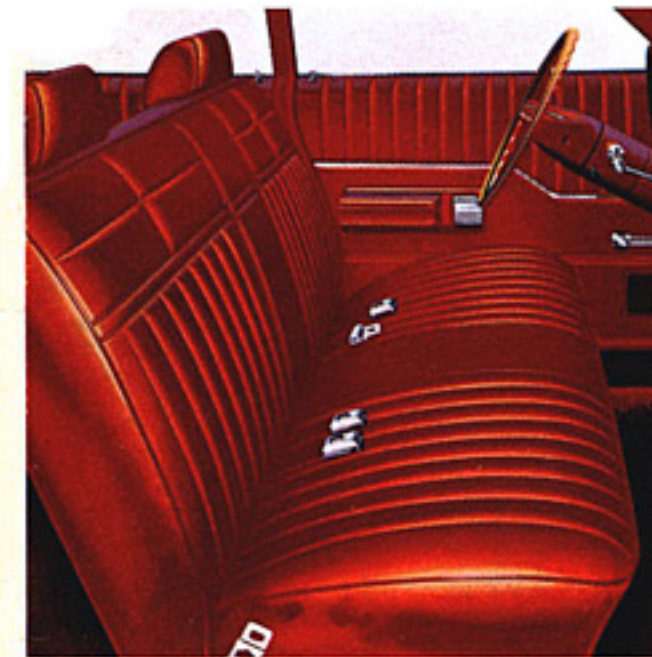

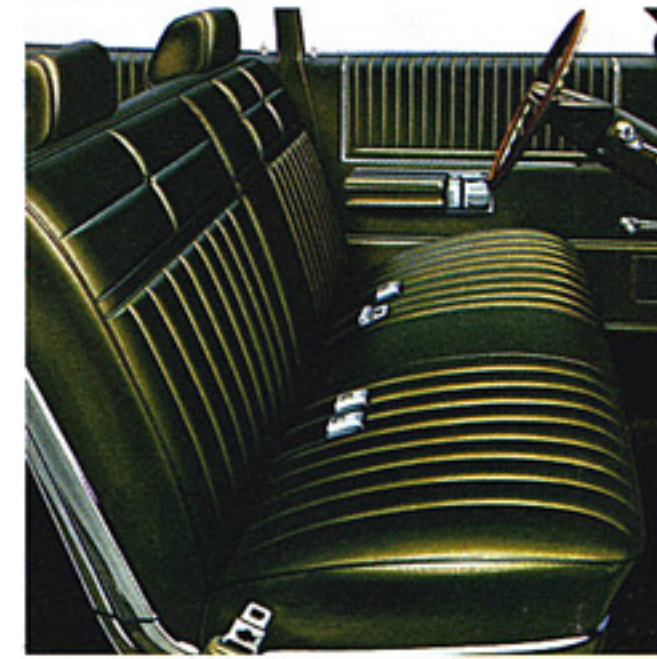




Marquis interior in all-vinyl

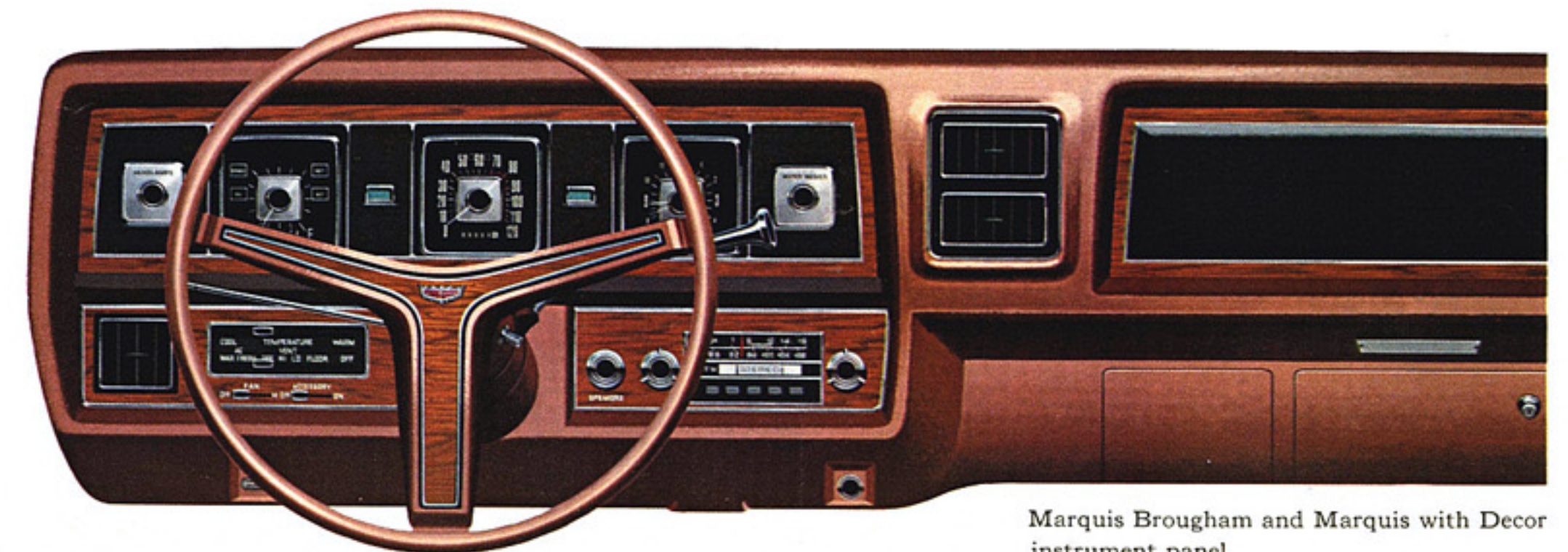
Shown on the left-hand page is the Brougham interior with optional Twin Comfort Lounge Seats and reclining front passenger seat in cloth-and-vinyl. The Twin Comfort Lounge Seats are individually adjustable and have separate center armrests. The reclining front passenger seat is an additional option which permits the front passenger to tilt his seat back further for resting on long trips. Available in either cloth-and-vinyl or all-vinyl, Twin Comfort Lounge Seats may be ordered for both Marquis Brougham and Marquis with Decor. The interior depicted is in dark tobacco, and it may also be ordered in black, medium blue, dark red, medium green and light gray gold. Medium ginger offered with all-vinyl interiors only.

On this page is the standard Marquis Brougham bench seat in light gray gold cloth-and-vinyl. Other colors available are black, medium blue, dark red, medium green and dark tobacco.

Also shown is the all-vinyl Marquis with Decor interior in medium green. The full-width bench seat is standard, and Marquis with Decor interiors may be ordered in your choice of cloth-and-vinyl or all-vinyl. Colors for the cloth-and-vinyl interiors include black, medium blue, dark red, medium green, light gray gold and dark tobacco. Medium ginger and white are additional colors offered with all-vinyl interiors; dark tobacco is not available.

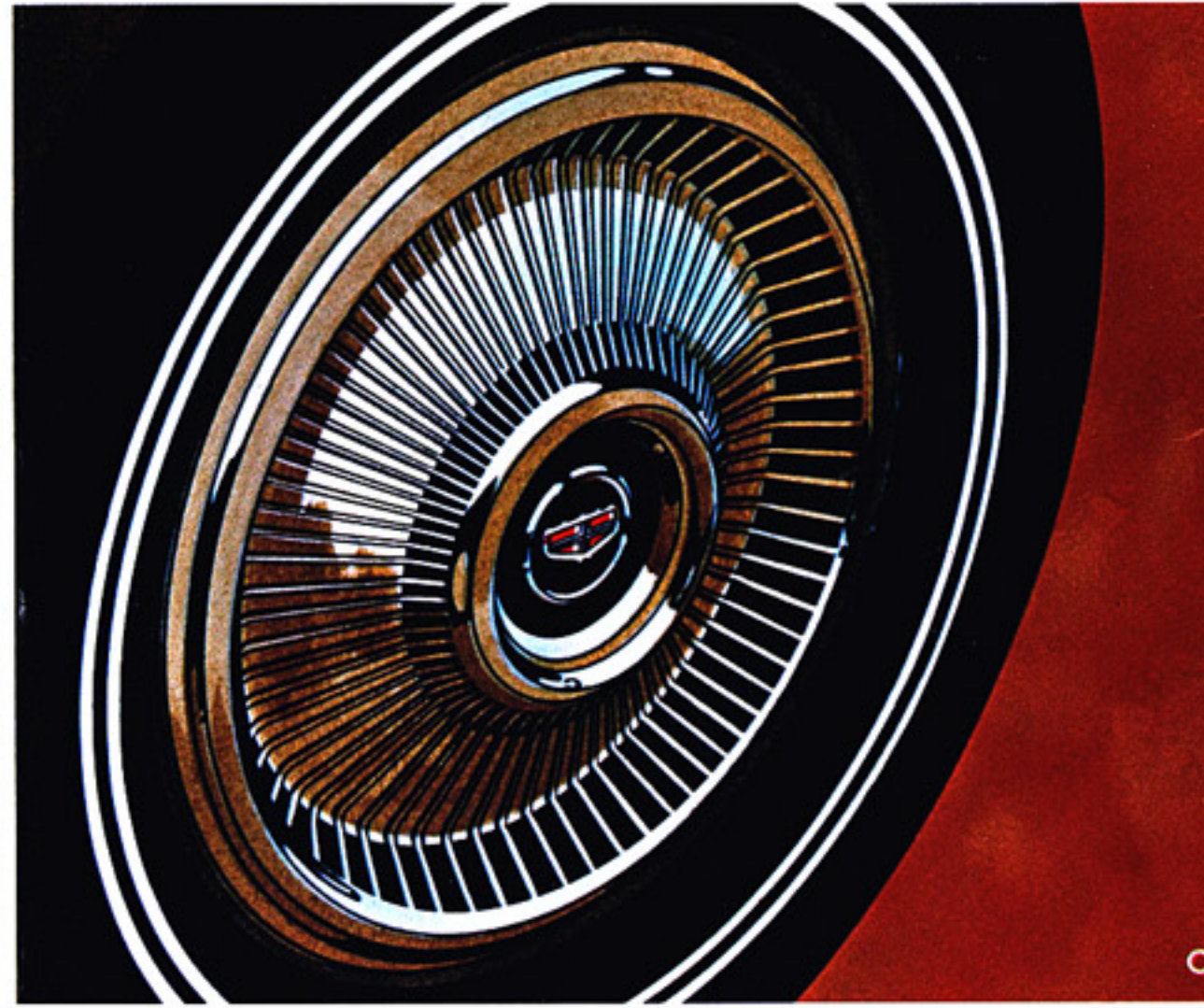
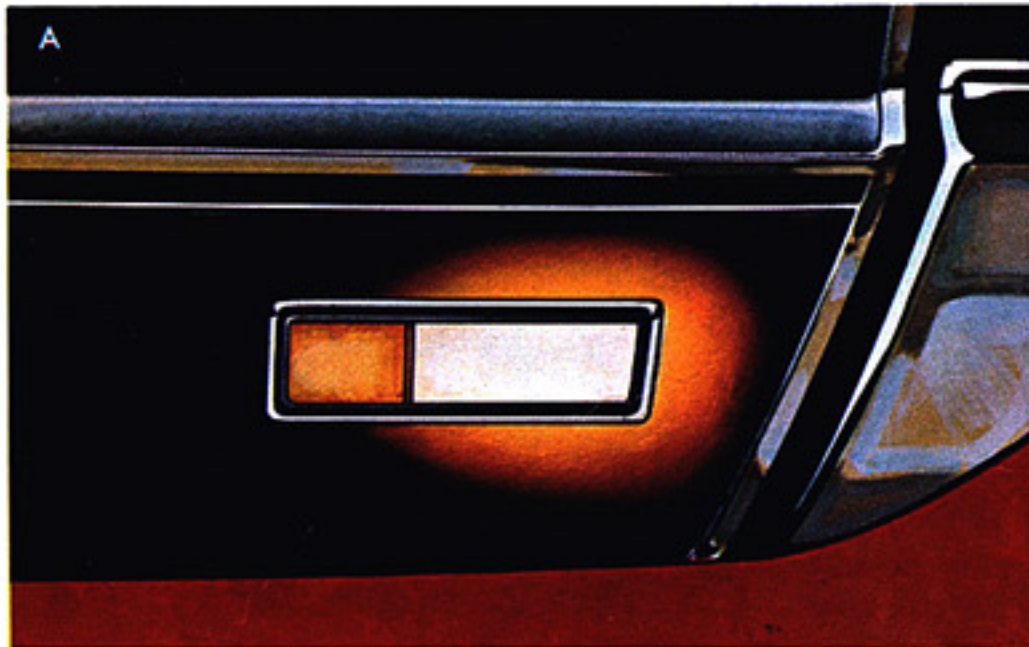
