

We made the family room bigger and added a door.

As a family vehicle with car-like comfort, Dodge Caravan's interior has always been the basis of its overall design. Building "from the inside out" made the original Dodge Caravan an outstanding people mover. And it still does.

Front to back, side to side, between and above the seats, you'll find more room than in any previous Dodge Caravan.



- New styling refinements from the carpeting to the headliner create a modern, family-friendly appearance.

- All seats are ride-tuned for comfort by matching seats and mounting systems to each other and to the vehicle's suspension.

- The unique convenience of a second sliding door is available on all 1996 Dodge Caravan and Grand Caravan models.

- Assist handles on the backs of both front seats are included on models equipped with the new available second sliding door.

Quad Command seating and bench seating are available on both Grand Caravan and Caravan models.

- A MINIVAN FIRST: An eight-way power driver's seat, including power recliner, is available on LE and standard on ES models.

- A second sliding door is available on all models for unobstructed access to the middle seat. An automatic lockout prevents the door from opening when the fuel door is also open.

- Higher roof improves middle seat head room.

- Longer body increases leg room in the middle and rear seats. Dodge Caravan is eight inches longer and Dodge Grand Caravan is almost seven inches longer than previous models.

- Dual air bags are standard. Always wear your seat belts.

- Step-in height is lower at the front doors and both sliding doors for easy entry and exit.

- A MINIVAN FIRST: Front seat Dual-Zone Temperature Control is available and allows separate temperature zones and controls for the driver and front seat passenger.

- Wider aisles improve walk-through room from the front seats to the rear seats.

- AN INDUSTRY FIRST: Mid-Cabin Comfort Control directs airflow to passengers in the middle seat. Standard on most Caravan models.

You won't have to out-wrestle an Easy Out Roller Seat.™

The aircraft-type wheels under the middle and rear bench seats snap down so you can reposition or remove a seat by simply rolling it. When reinstalling the seat, the wheels snap back up and lock.

- Removable Quad Command seats have reclining seatbacks that also fold forward for cargo or for use as a tray table. Cup holders are built into each seatback.

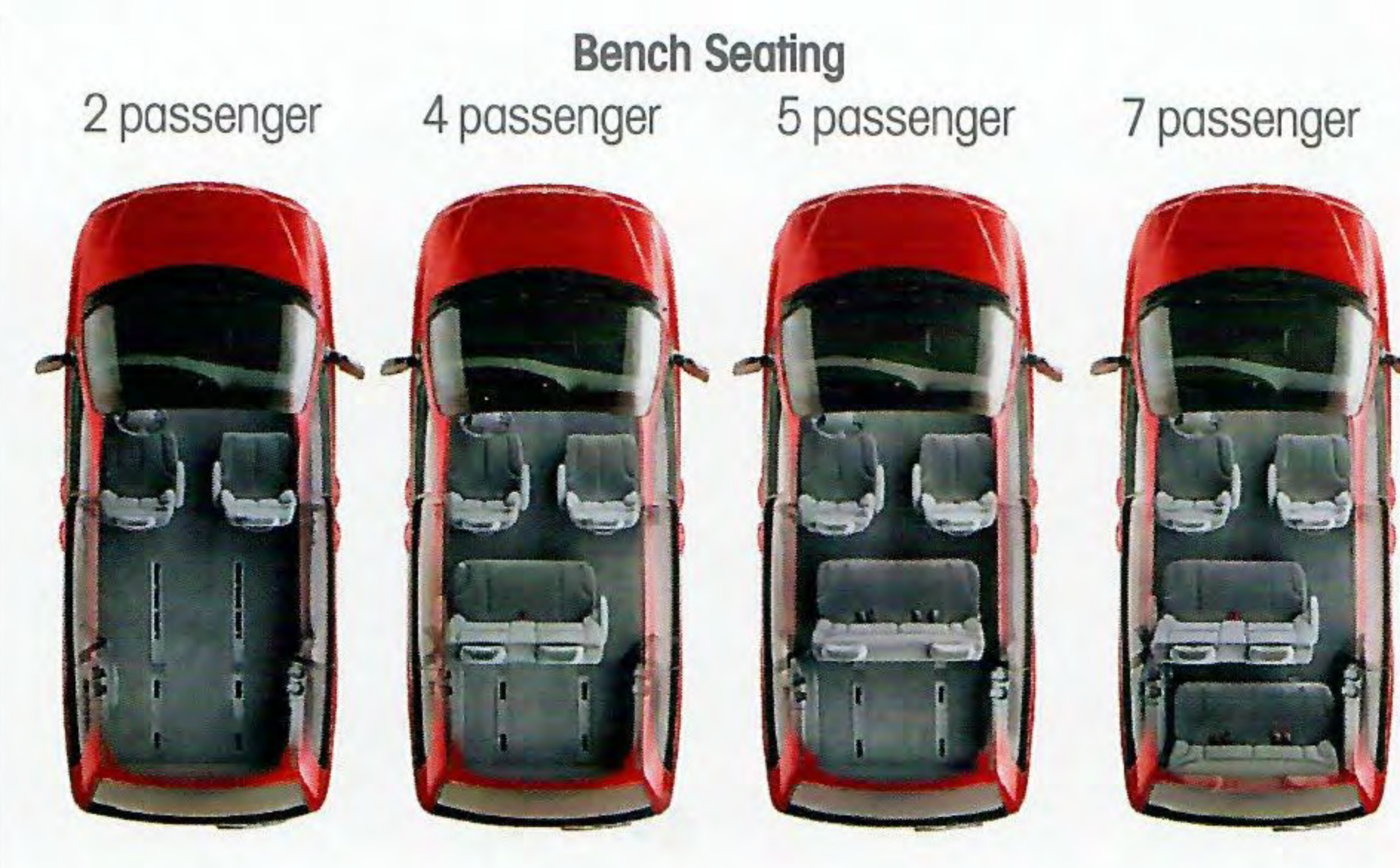
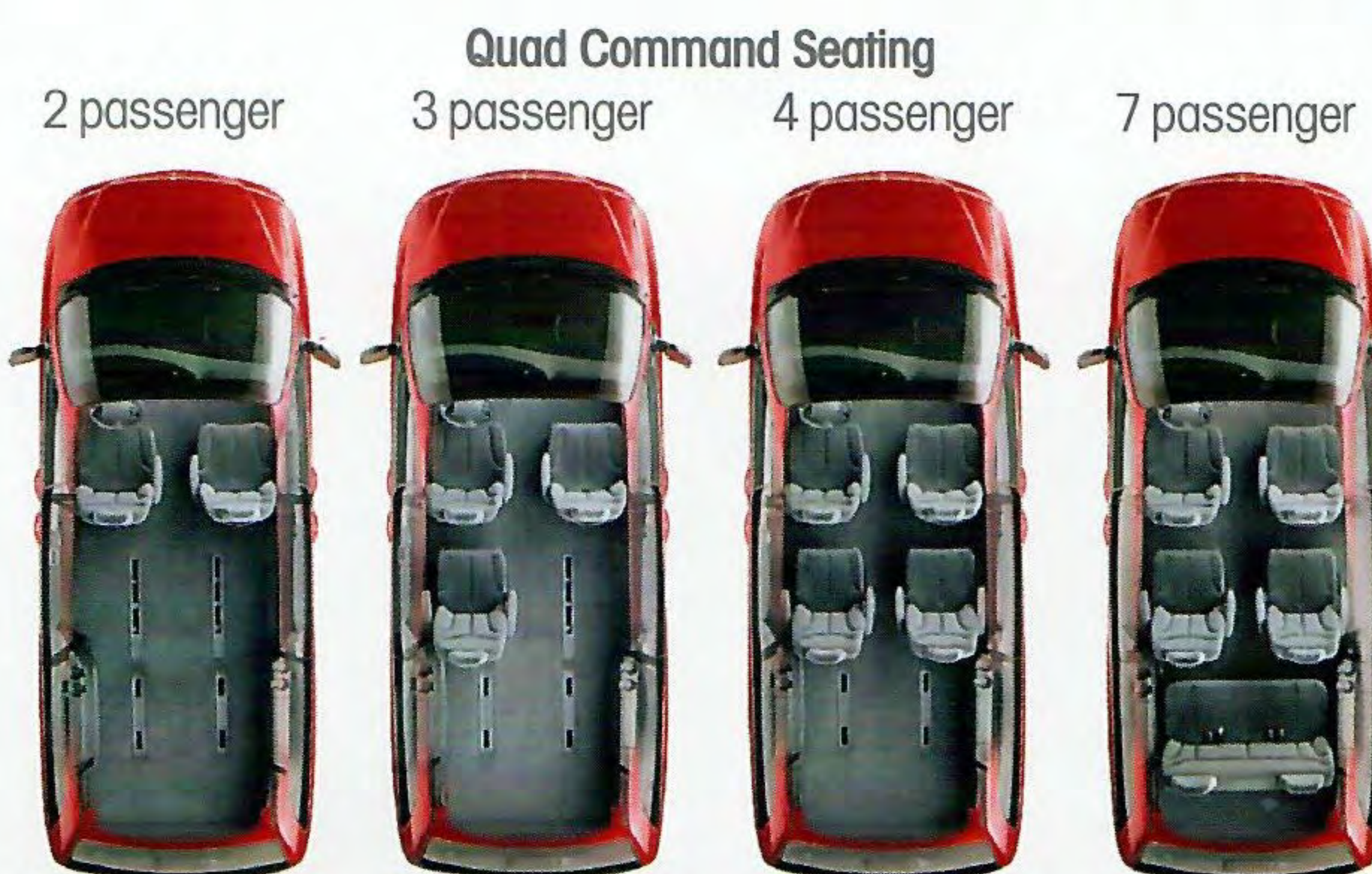
- New rear heater/air conditioning unit provides maximum comfort for middle and rear seat passengers. Available on Dodge Grand Caravan SE, LE and ES models.

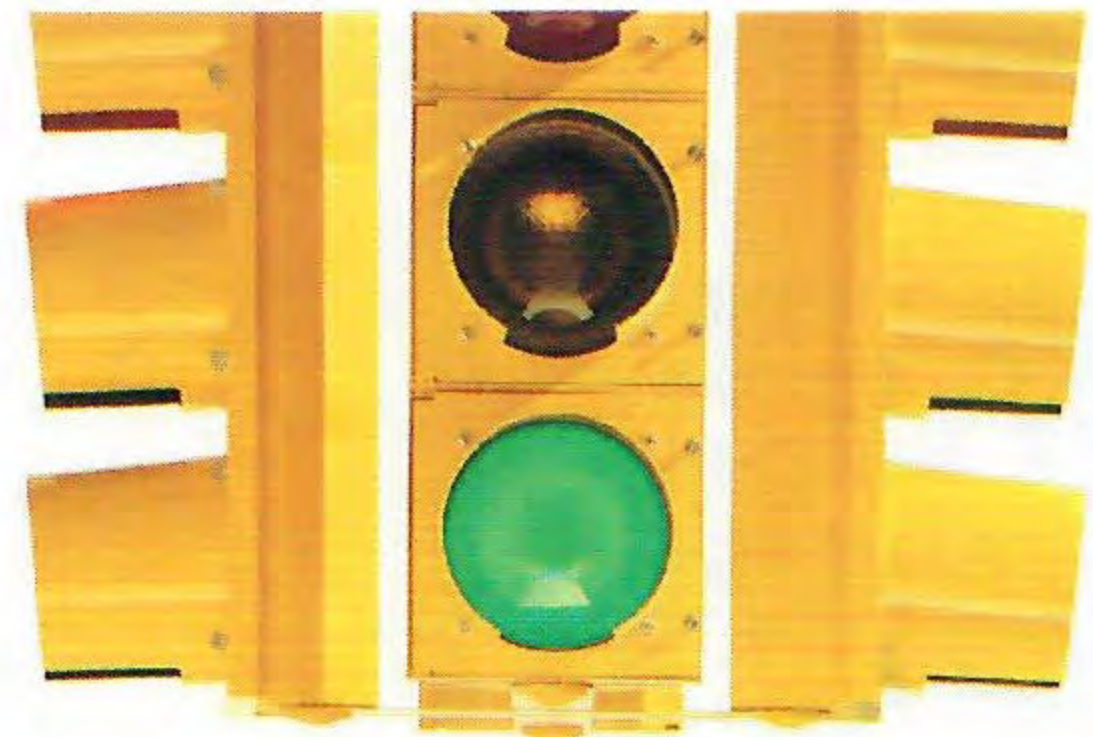
- New rear seat head restraints for outboard occupants in the middle and rear seats are available and easily removable.

- Fits the width of most single garage door openings. Even with a wider body and larger rearview mirrors, a 1996 Dodge Caravan or Grand Caravan can be parked in an average-sized garage.

- 5.4-inch wider body increases shoulder room.

- Up to 12 cup holders, depending on choice of seating, are located throughout the vehicle.





We pushed out the walls, raised the ceiling and enlarged the windows.



- 32 percent larger windshield improves overall visibility to put you more in control as a driver.

- Upper visibility in front is improved 20 percent by increasing the height of the windshield.

- Higher roof creates more head room, especially for second seat passengers.

- Larger side windows improve visibility and are virtually flush for a neat appearance and smooth, aerodynamic surfaces.

- All windows are tinted to reduce road glare and heat from the sun.

- Lower liftgate sill and a flush floor allow easier seat and cargo removal.

- Front air dam provides a major reduction in air drag.

- Longer overall body for additional leg room and new cargo-carrying versatility (see pages 12 and 13). Dodge Caravan is eight inches longer overall and Dodge Grand Caravan is almost seven inches longer.

- Cab-forward design positions the wheels toward the corners for maximum interior room.

- Forward up and down visibility overall is best in class. The instrument panel is 3.9 inches lower and the windshield header sight line is 4.9 degrees higher.

- A front-wheel-drive automatic transaxle is standard for good traction and reliable power delivery.

- Unchanged floor height maintains a command-of-the-road view for the driver and provides full suspension travel for the new available 16-inch wheels.

- 1.4-inch lower front door sills improve entry and exit.

- Wider body provides up to five inches more shoulder room for passengers.

- One-inch longer wheelbase on short-wheelbase Dodge Caravans provides more interior length and a smoother ride.

- Solar-Control Glass and sunscreen glass are available on models equipped with air conditioning. Solar-Control Glass is used for the windshield and front door windows to lower the peak interior temperature. Deep-tinted sunscreen glass is used for the side and liftgate windows.

- Three-inch wider front track and almost two-inch wider rear track improve handling and reduce turning circle.

- Steering column and new three-spoke steering wheel are repositioned for better driver comfort and control.

- New ergonomic cockpit puts 85 percent of the controls within an arm's-length reach of most drivers.

- Optional speed control has button switches integrated into the steering wheel.

- New 10-position tilt steering column has additional positions for more personalized adjustment.



- Antiglare design instrument panel has a black low-gloss finish top.

- New instrument panel gauges have larger graphics and are backlit for better nighttime visibility.

In keeping with Dodge Caravan's heritage of building from the inside out, we began designing the 1996 Dodge Caravan by enlarging Caravan's previous shape (shown outlined above), and then rounded off the corners to create the roomiest, most comfortable and most versatile Dodge Caravan ever.

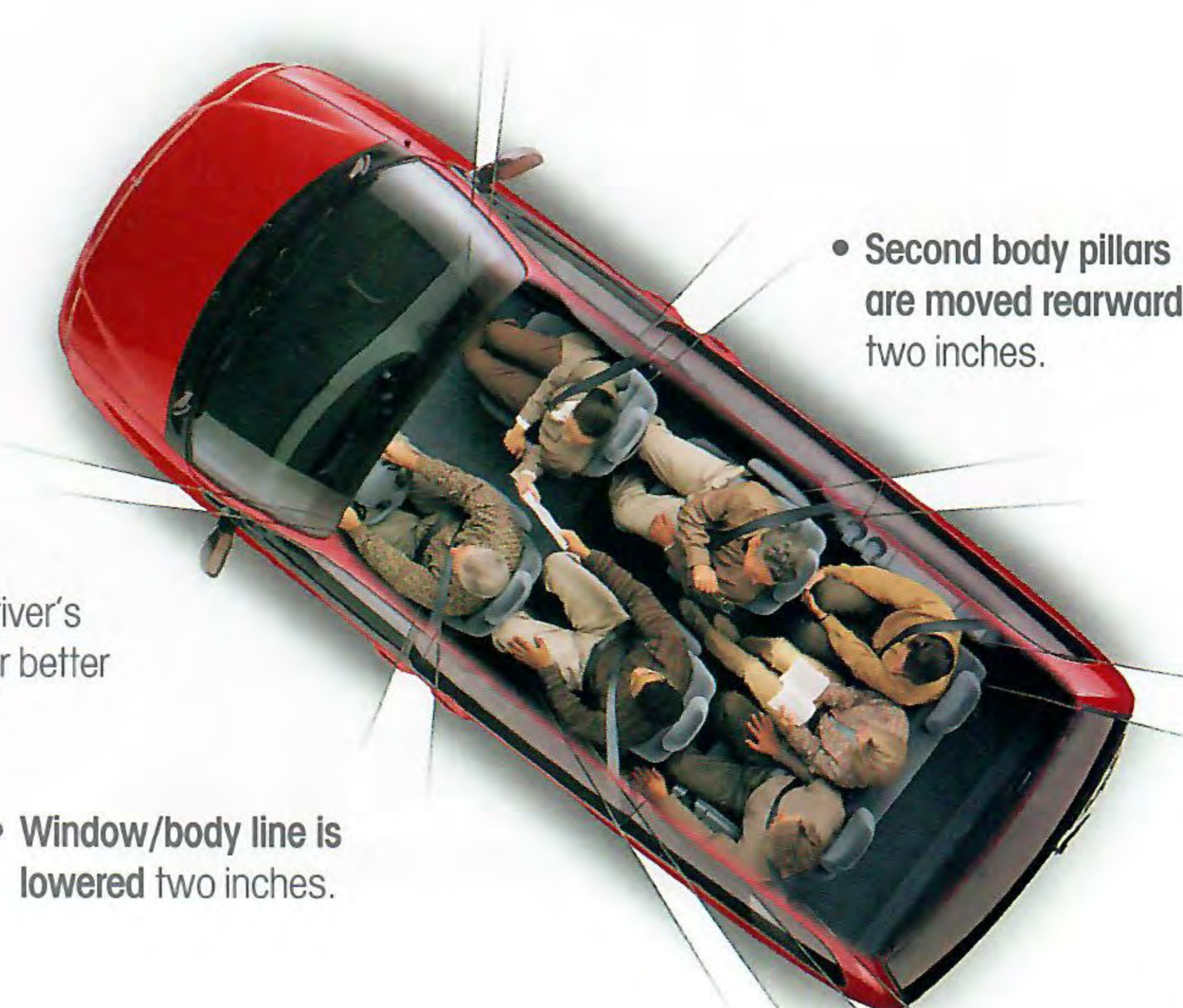

Improved Sight Lines:

- Windshield pillars are positioned out of the driver's prime visibility zones for better peripheral vision.

- Window/body line is lowered two inches.



- Second body pillars are moved rearward two inches.



We put more into it, so you could too.

The new short-wheelbase Dodge Caravan has 30 percent more cargo capacity (rear seats removed) than last year, and the new Dodge Grand Caravan has 27 percent more. Compared size-for-size to other minivans, the roomier new Dodge Caravan has the most cargo capacity in its class.

As a result, the 1996 Dodge Caravan and Grand Caravan can carry loads you wouldn't even attempt in most other minivans.



Grand Caravan can carry bulky loads up to eight-feet long like this riding garden tractor.

- An available second sliding door improves access to the interior for easier loading and unloading.
- A MINIVAN EXCLUSIVE: Flat cargo floor carries 4' x 8' sheets of material in a Dodge Grand Caravan with the liftgate closed. Or carries a 4' x 8' sheet of material on top of folded middle and rear seats, also with the liftgate closed.
- Unobstructed underseat storage accommodates long items such as skis or 2" x 4" pieces of lumber.
- A MINIVAN EXCLUSIVE: The best-in-class weight-to-volume ratio for a strong, lightweight design. The long-wheelbase Dodge Grand Caravan shown above has the largest interior volume in its class, yet weighs less than some smaller competitors. The short-wheelbase Dodge Caravan has similar weight-to-volume characteristics.

- Full-open position of the liftgate is above the heads of most adults, but low enough to reach.

- The liftgate's inside handle is recessed so it does not reduce cargo volume and is out of the way.
- A longer overall body than previous Caravan models helps provide the best-in-class cargo capacity. The new Dodge Caravan is eight inches longer overall; the new Dodge Grand Caravan is almost seven inches longer.
- The rear liftgate sill is lower and is flush with the door for easier cargo handling and removal or placement of the new Easy Out Roller Seats.[™]

- More width between the wheelhouses than previous models provides more room for loads like 4' x 8' sheets of material.

- New temperature-compensated liftgate gas props prevent the buildup of gas pressure that can increase closing effort in hot weather.
- Rear overhang is longer than previous models for more cargo room.

- Available roof luggage rack has tie-downs at the ends of the crossrails to secure cargo. For minimum wind noise, the crossrails are airfoil shaped.



- More storage room behind the rear seat than previous models for luggage, coolers, bicycles, golf clubs ... you name it.

Passive and active safety features surround you.

Passive safety features, such as air bags* and side-guard door beams, help protect you and your family during a collision. Active safety features, such as standard antilock brakes, help you avoid a collision.

Like previous Dodge Caravans, the 1996 Dodge Caravan is a leader in safety. As a result, the 1996 Dodge Caravan meets or exceeds all federal passenger car safety standards for 1998.†

- **Advanced dual air bags*** feature a new compact design for less weight and better visibility of the instruments. When used with standard lap and shoulder restraints, Dodge Caravan's dual air bags* are among the most advanced safety systems available for the driver and front seat passenger in a minivan.

- A seamless cover on the instrument panel door for the passenger-side air bag. While eliminating unsightly seams and hinges, the new cover also helps prevent theft of the air bag.

- **New Comfort-Fit Seat Belt System™** includes these features:
 - A **MINIVAN FIRST:** Shoulder belt height adjusters for both outboard passengers in the middle seat position as well as for the driver and front passenger.

- Front seat restraint system buckles are attached to the seat frames, instead of the floor, so the buckles also move when the seat is moved for added comfort.
- New super-soft seat belt webbing for all seat belts.



- **Unibelt lap and shoulder restraints** to help protect all front and rear outboard passengers. A lap belt is provided for the center passenger in the three-passenger rear bench seat.

- **AN INDUSTRY FIRST:** New seatbacks for the available dual Integrated Child Safety Seats recline and are now adjustable to several positions.
- **New T-shield seat belt system** for the dual Integrated Child Safety Seats allows easy operation. In one motion, you can pull the combined harness/buckle T-shield over the child's head and latch it to the center of the seat cushion.
- **Child-protection door locks on the right-side and new available left-side sliding doors** prevent children from opening the doors from the inside.



- **Sun visor extenders** increase protection from low-angled sunlight. Available on SE and standard on LE and ES models.



- **Steel side-guard door beams** are standard in all front and sliding side doors.

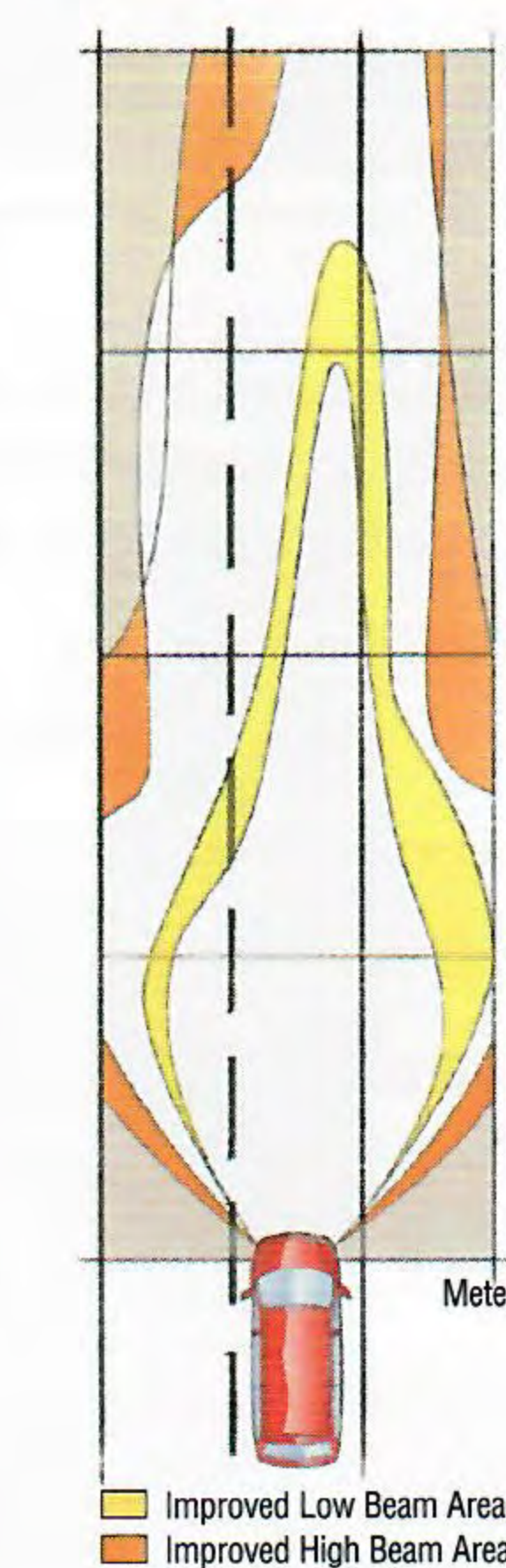


- **Fuel filler interlock** prevents the new available second sliding door from opening when the fuel door is opened.
- **Adjustable head restraints** for all outboard seating positions are standard with Quad Command seats and on ES models. They are included with deluxe seating or available as a dealer-installed option.
- **Knee blockers integrated into the instrument panel** help provide a "soft ride down" of impact energy for front seat occupants during a collision.

- **New windshield wiper system** has opposed 23.5-inch long wiper blades, among the longest in the industry.
- **New available patented electric windshield wiper deicer** helps prevent the buildup of ice at the base of the windshield and on the wiper blades.



- **Improved rear washer/wiper system** has a swept angle of 172 degrees — the largest liftgate wiper pattern in the industry.
- **Electric rear window defroster** available for the liftgate heats a 10 percent larger area than the previous design for improved reduction of ice buildup.



- **New halogen headlights** are 20 percent brighter than last year for better visibility down the road.



- **Larger outside mirrors** are body-mounted for better stability than door-mounted mirrors.

- **Four-wheel ABS** is now standard on all models for short stopping distances and to maintain directional stability by preventing wheel lockup.

Other Safety Features:

- **Parking brake pedal travel is reduced 50 percent.**
- **Brake pedal travel required to activate the brakes is reduced** by a new standard power brake booster first used in the Dodge Viper sports car.
- **Dual-action rear brakes** provide consistently smooth operation to help stop the vehicle when moving and powerful holding ability for the parking brake.
- **Automatic front-wheel-drive transaxle** is proved over billions of miles for its ability to aid stability and control.
- **Fuel tank is mounted for impact protection** ahead of the rear suspension and between the bodyside rails.
- **Dual braking system** uses separate brake fluid reservoirs to provide a reserve braking system if one system does not operate.

The 1996 Dodge Caravan has many sophisticated features designed to maintain your personal security and to help prevent theft of your vehicle or its contents.

New Security

- **Available remote keyless entry system** includes a new "panic" mode to ward off persons near the vehicle by turning on the interior lights, flashing the headlights and blowing the horn intermittently for up to three minutes.
- **Additional tumblers in the door locks** significantly increase the number of possible key combinations to help prevent theft.
- A **patented park/ignition interlock** is standard to prevent moving the transaxle shifter out of Park when the ignition switch is in the "lock" position. A steering wheel lock is also standard.
- **New anti-theft front door locks** are much tougher to force open.
- **New available vehicle theft security alarm** protects the vehicle from unauthorized entry by monitoring a hood switch, door ajar switches, ignition circuit, power door lock/unlock circuits and a liftgate lock sensor.



- A **variety of cellular phones** are available for general communications and on-the-road emergency assistance. See your Dodge salesperson for more information.

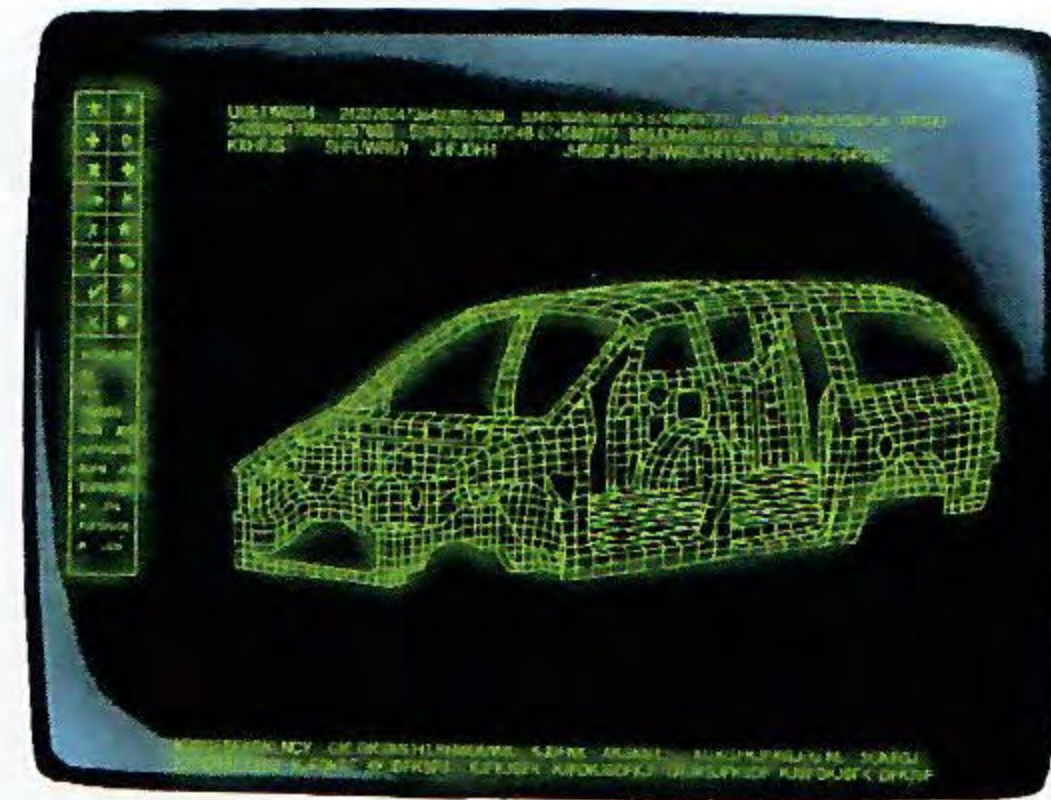

The 1996 Dodge Caravan surrounds you and your family with advanced engineering that would be considered world-class even on an exotic sports car: a rigid, precisely built body structure to prevent buzzes, squeaks and rattles; heavy-duty weatherproofing and sound insulation; an "intelligent" computer system network; a new self-leveling rear suspension system* available on all LE, ES and Grand Caravan models ... and more as described.

Someday, Dodge Caravan's competitors may have all of these features. But for now, only the new original does — in true world-class style.

* Late availability.



- **Outstanding bending and torsional stiffness** minimizes noise and vibrations while firming up the ride and handling. On smooth or rough roads, the stiff body structure produces a solid feeling of control for the driver and a stable ride for the passengers.

- **Tough Unibody construction** welds body sheet metal and structural members into one strong, unitized framework for maximum rigidity with low weight.

- **Box-section construction** is used for windshield pillars, bodyside sills, door opening frames and other areas where extra strength is required.

- **Precise fit of flush body panels** and tight-fitting doors and trim reduce wind noise and water leaks.

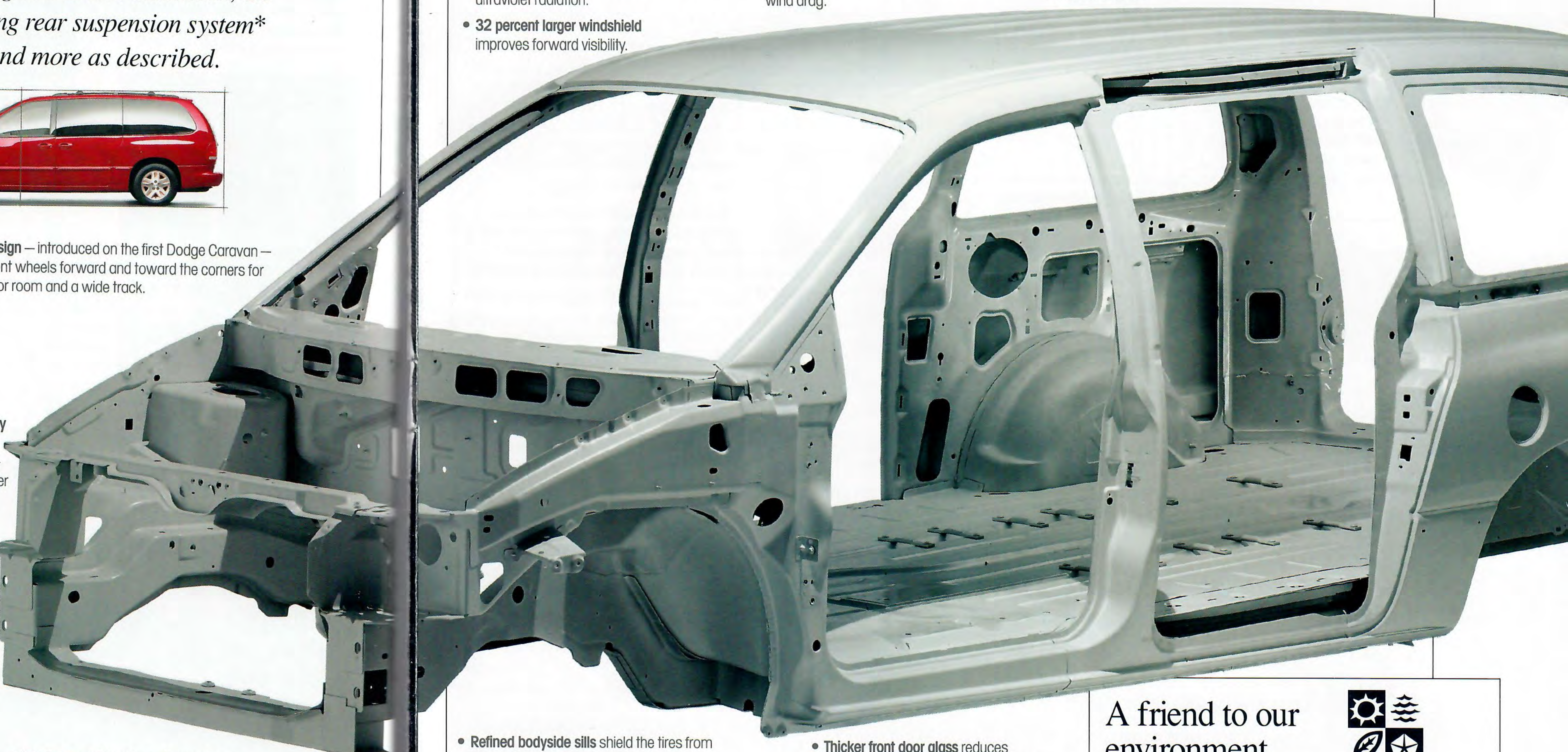


- **Two full-door weatherstrip seals and a third seal** on the top and bottom of each door keep out the elements and reduce wind noise.

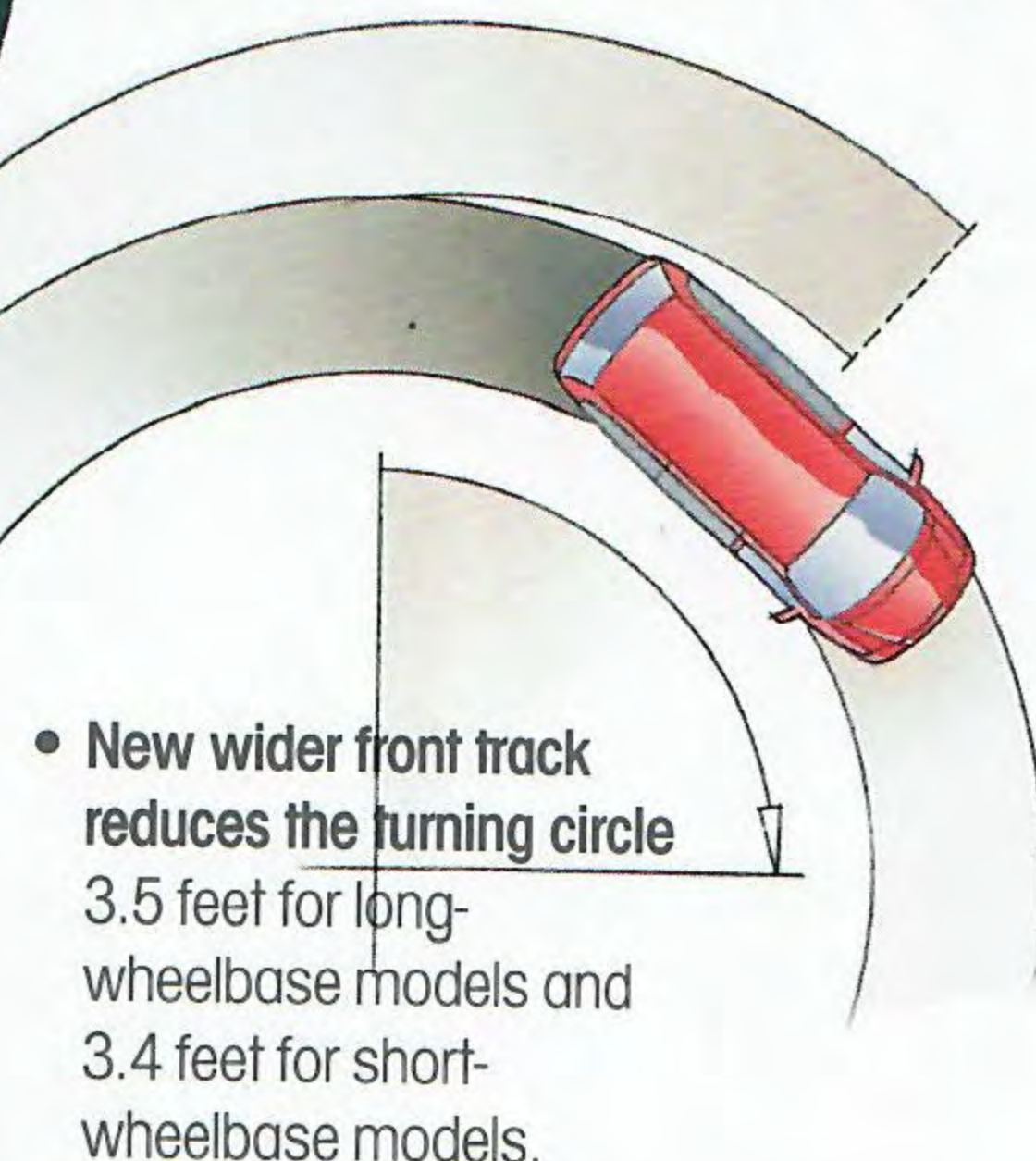
- **A MINIVAN EXCLUSIVE: Weight-to-volume ratio of the body structure is best in class** for a strong, lightweight design. Dodge Grand Caravan has more interior volume than long-wheelbase competitors, yet weighs less than some smaller competitors. The short-wheelbase Dodge Caravan has a similar excellent weight-to-volume ratio.

- **AN INDUSTRY FIRST: Improved MacPherson strut front suspension** has larger upper strut mounts than last year to increase up and down suspension travel for a smooth ride. Chrysler Corporation was granted a U.S. patent for this exclusive feature.

- **Cab-forward design** — introduced on the first Dodge Caravan — positions the front wheels forward and toward the corners for maximum interior room and a wide track.



- **Interior sound levels at all speeds are significantly lower** than previous Dodge Caravans.



- **New wider front track reduces the turning circle** 3.5 feet for long-wheelbase models and 3.4 feet for short-wheelbase models.

- **AN INDUSTRY FIRST: Cast aluminum front suspension crossmember** is 20 pounds lighter than a similar design in steel and uses tuned rubber isolators to control vibration and to damp out noise. This is the first use of a major cast aluminum structural member in a U.S. production vehicle.

- **Noise-reducing baffles** are heat expanded during assembly to fill openings in the side sills, windshield pillars, liftgate pillars, and front door opening roof rails.

- **Air drag is over 10 percent less** than the previous Dodge Caravan body from a new lower hood, steeply raked windshield, front air dam, nearly flush front door side glass and other refinements.

- **Antichip epoxy polyester primer** on the entire body provides superior protection against damage from road stones and ultraviolet radiation.

- **32 percent larger windshield** improves forward visibility.

- **Almost 50 pounds of noise reduction body materials have been added.** These materials include baked-on mastics, conformable noise-damping "spot" patches, adhesive-backed mastic body patches over body openings, and others.

- **Dash panel silencer** on the engine side combines a barrier sheet, a sound-absorbing pad and an air gap to minimize engine compartment noise.

- **Larger, flush side window glass** increases lateral visibility and minimizes wind drag.



- **Bodyside moldings and available cladding** protect against dings from opening car doors and shopping carts.

- **Rear suspension uses rubber "biscuits"** to isolate the springs from the axle for a smooth ride. A new track bar increases lateral stiffness for a steadier ride.

- **A full-perimeter tubular weatherstrip seals the liftgate opening.** An additional weatherstrip at the top of the opening also helps keep water out of the cargo area.

- **Refined bodyside sills** shield the tires from the airflow to help reduce air drag.

- **New "intelligent" wiring network** connects Caravan's electronic control modules, sensors and operating circuits to a single wiring network so they can exchange data for more precise operation and be monitored for easier servicing. The new network and a simplified power harness eliminate dozens of circuits and splices for improved reliability.

- **AN INDUSTRY FIRST: Positive Temperature Coefficient Devices** act as resettable fuses to protect against electrical overloads and are utilized on available power door locks, power windows and other power features.

- **Battery saver feature in the body control computer** automatically turns off electrical loads that would discharge the battery when the engine is not running. Any interior lights left on, for example, are turned off after 15 minutes. Exterior lights are turned off after three minutes. The feature can be manually overridden.

- **Thicker front door glass** reduces transmission of wind and road noise.

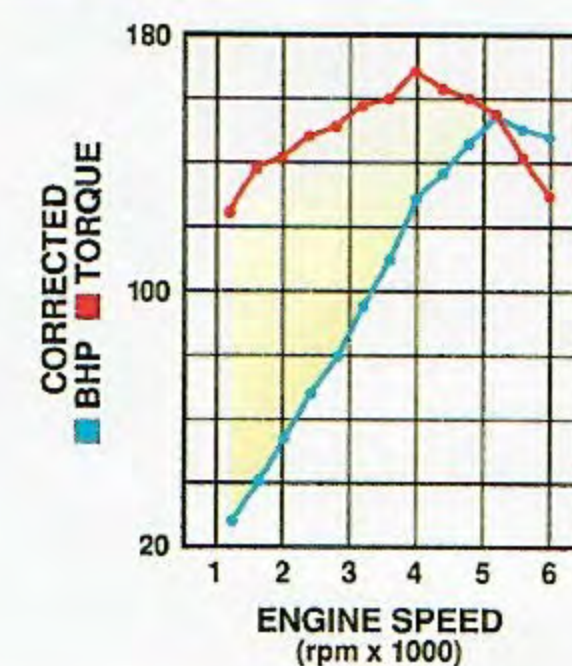
The design and manufacture of the new Dodge Caravan show Chrysler Corporation's ongoing commitment to preserving the resources and quality of our environment. For example:

- **Hazardous materials are eliminated from many vehicle components.** Brake linings are asbestos-free, cadmium is eliminated from virtually all fasteners, and air conditioning refrigerant is non-CFC.
- **Recycling codes are printed on new rubber and plastic parts**, such as fascias, bodyside moldings, trim panels, etc.
- **Compliance with strict evaporative emissions standards** helps keep fuel supply system vapors out of the atmosphere.
- **Advanced emission control systems** are designed to function effectively for at least 100,000 miles.
- **New waterborne base color coat paints** eliminate the environmental hazards of solvent-based sprays.
- **State-of-the-art manufacturing procedures** feature extensive recycling of assembly materials and the reduced use and proper disposal of hazardous substances.

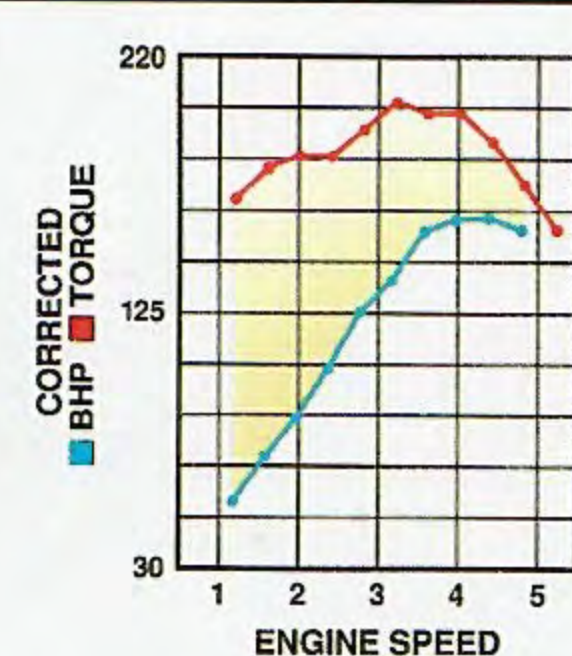
